### Home study Requirements:

- Submission of chapter tests and unit tests from the textbook
- Submission of <u>Advent Family Lessons by January 15</u> OR <u>Lent Family Lessons by April 25</u> (Information to be sent via email)
- Submission of Family Life assignment and book by January 15
- Submission of family activities log by May 31

### Details for requirements below:

#### Chapter/Unit Test Schedule and Instructions

- \* Read through the chapter before your child does.
- Have your child read through the lesson; depending upon age and needs, you may do this with him or her.
- ❖ Children must complete the <u>chapter test at the end of each chapter</u>, as well as the <u>unit test at the end of each unit</u>. When completed, please tear out these pages from the book (please make sure your child's *name and grade* are at the top of the page) and put the pages in an envelope to either drop off to the Religious Education Office or mail to us at:

### By February 15 – Unit 2 (Lessons 8 through 12)

\*Please review lesson 20 on Lent and lesson 21 on The Three Day (no chapter test for these lessons, just review)

### By March 31 – Unit 3 (Lessons 15 through 19)

\*Please review lesson 27 on Easter (no chapter test for these lessons, just review)

## By May 15 - Unit 4 (Lessons 22 through 26)

\*Please review lesson 6 on The Church Year and lesson 7 on Ordinary Time (no chapter test for these lessons, just review)

### **Family Life Instructions**

Families receive the Family Life book, letter with instructions, and assignment upon pick-up of materials. All the information needed to complete this assignment is in the letter. Please note: we reuse the Family Life books, so please do not write in them and make sure to return them with the assignments by January 15<sup>th</sup>, as we will use them for our weekly program as well.

## Family Activities Log Instructions\*

Students must attend at least 4 parish events during the year, and turn in the log by May 31st. Students must bring their activities log to each event to have them stamped (we will have designated adults at events to do this.) We recommend taking a picture of the log as your child completes activities just in case the log gets lost.
