THIS IS ENOUGH!

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

"This is enough!" We hear these words today in our 1st reading. They belong to Elijah the Prophet. They could belong to each one of us, I'm sure, whenever things go from bad to worse.

How many times have we expressed this very sentiment regarding a host of issues: abortion ... violence on our streets ... war and terrorism ... addiction ... racism ... hatred ... sexual abuse ...

Once again, we have been hearing in the news awful stories of the abuse of children, adolescents and young adults by clergy, even a Cardinal. (If it hasn't already been reported, very soon a report on clergy sexual abuse in dioceses throughout Pennsylvania will soon be released.)

I remember when we went through a major crisis like this back in 2002. I cannot believe we are going through it yet again! It sickens me, disheartens me and angers me ... as I'm sure it does you.

Not only do the victims of abuse deserve an apology, but so do you, the people in the pews; you too deserve an apology. You have been let down, betrayed. I am so deeply sorry.

Since 2002, our Church has done much to ensure the safety of our children and all who are vulnerable. We responded in a positive way back then. We must do the same today ... and even more.

As Father Jorge recently said to me, "We need new saints and heroes to show us the way of Jesus!" I believe Jesus is calling all of us to be those new saints and heroes! We can, and we must, renew our Church as St. Francis and St. Clare, as St. Dominic and St. Theresa once did!

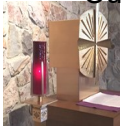

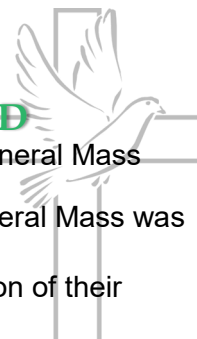
