IMPORTANT THANK YOUS

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I write this to you on Wednesday morning of Carnival Week. I suspect by the weekend I won't have much of a voice left, so before it goes entirely I want to offer a very loud and enthusiastic THANK YOU to everyone involved — workers and patrons — in our annual Carnival. It's importance as a community builder struck me more than ever this week. We need to come together. This is what we should do as Church, as a Christ-centered community ... bring people together! Unite people! Isn't this what Jesus did?

I also want to thank all of you who have written me letters, notes, emails, or called me or met with me to discuss the devastating clergy sex abuse that came to light in the recent Pennsylvania report. In my remarks last Sunday I said we cannot blame others (the press, for example); instead, I said, "This is on us." Hearing that, one person wrote me, saying: "This sin hasn't been 'mine' before now; however, if I do not take this last reckoning as a call to hold the Catholic Church accountable and to push the Leadership to change, the blame becomes Mine." Perfectly said. We all need to hear this. Thank you.

This past week I also received a wonderful note from Patricia Quinter, the principal of Holy Name School in Camden, thanking all of YOU, St. Joan of Arc parishioners, for donating school supplies of every kind that filled TEN large containers. These supplies "will be put to good use all year long." Ms. Quinter asks God's blessings upon all who sacrificed "for our children."

This is what Church is for. This is what Jesus wants us to do.

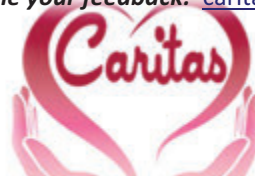

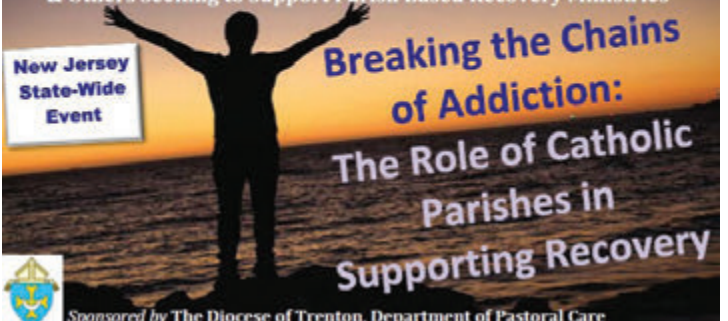

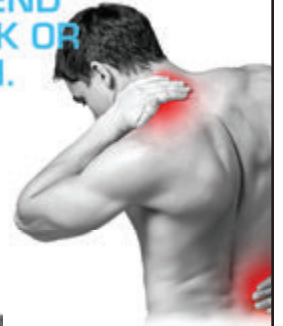
