Dear Parishioners and Friends,

People frequently comment that whenever they drive by our church and school, day or night, they always see many cars in the parking lot. That's double-true for September! All sorts of ministries, groups and organizations are now in full swing. If you look on the parish calendar you will see that most, if not all, of our space is occupied, especially in the evenings.

This is a sign of a healthy parish. An active parish. Sunday Mass is, of course, the heart and soul of our spiritual lives as Catholic Christians. But we grow in our discipleship, in our relationship with Jesus Christ and one another, in and through these many ministries and activities. This is also how we serve others, reaching out to the hurting, helping those in need. This is how we continue the work of Jesus Christ.

During the summer, the Evesham Planning Board gave our project a "thumbs up" and we are now in the process of securing necessary permits. Our hope is that in the next few weeks, building will begin. This is exciting news.

Please know how grateful I am for all of you, our St. Joan of Arc Parishioners. Your commitment to your faith in Jesus Christ, and to your parish, overwhelms and inspires me. I know I speak for Fr. Jorge and Fr. Michael, as well as our Deacons and Sisters and entire staff. Let's continue to do all we can to build up the Kingdom of God ... to celebrate, proclaim and share the love of God with everyone!

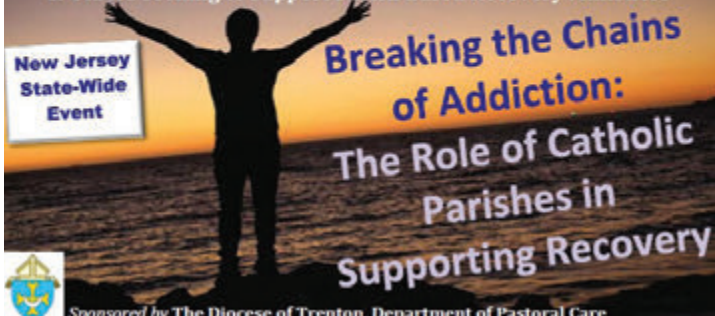
