## Her Last Word, the Most Important

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

They burned Joan of Arc at the stake. It was her punishment for trumped up charges of heresy after a mockery of a trial. Before she died, as the flames surrounded her, she asked that a crucifix be held in front of her so that she could keep her eyes on it. Then, she spoke the last word anyone heard from her lips. She said, "Jesus."

### Jesus.

Some say she said his name three times.

She kept her eyes on him, she spoke his name as she died.

When did you first meet Jesus? How has your relationship with him grown ... or not ... through the years? Do you need to meet him again? Christianity is, before anything else, about a relationship with Jesus Christ as our Savior and Lord of our lives.

In today's Gospel, Jesus asked his disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" He asks each of us the same question today.

Hopefully, all that we do here at St. Joan of Arc Parish is to develop and strengthen our relationship with Jesus. I urge everyone to join a faith-sharing small group this October (or, join our new *Women's Bible Study* or *That Man is You*). 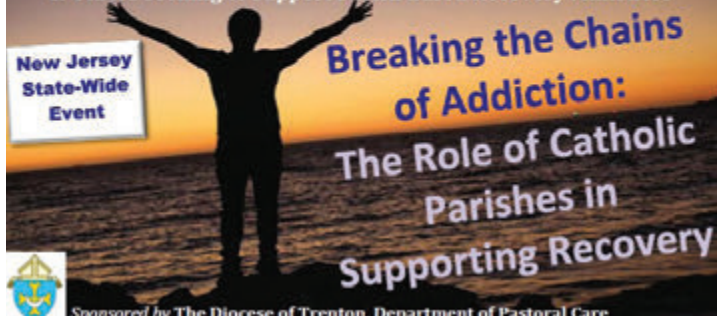

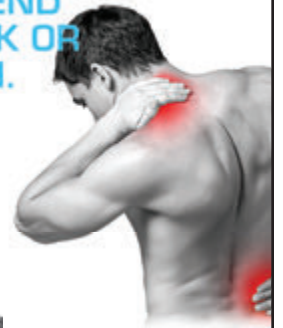
