OPEN TO LEARN SOMETHING NEW?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

By now I'm sure everyone is adjusting to the rhythms of a new school year. The kids are back in school but they aren't the only students. We are *all* learners, especially when it comes to our faith in Jesus Christ.

Get ready for a jolt. That's how Jesus sometimes teaches us. We see him in today's Gospel sticking his fingers into the ears of a deaf man, touching his tongue, saying an emphatic, "**Be opened!**"

When we are baptized, something similar happens. The ears and mouth of the newly baptized are touched and prayed over. 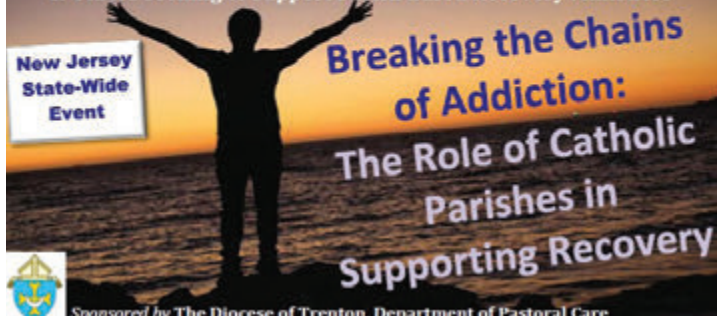
