40 DAYS FOR LIFE.

Now through November 4th

Lauren left her home in Pennsville this morning with every intention of aborting her 6 week old fetus. She already has one child with Down's Syndrome and this seemed like the best choice. When she arrived at the Cherry Hill Women's Center 45 minutes later she saw someone praying outside.

Lauren went inside the facility and she was given an ultrasound because the abortionist needed to know what procedure to do and how much money to charge. Lauren asked to see the ultrasound. It was then that she got up and left the Cherry Hill Women's Center.

Lauren spoke with me when she was waiting for her ride home. She said she changed her mind and told me her story. She showed me the "picture" she got. I asked if she needed help, but she said no. She said, "Thank you for being here. It really made me think".

I had just gotten there about 10 minutes before. It wasn't me who made her think. The point is that somebody was there being Christ's Hands and Feet. And because that person was there a baby who was scheduled to die today will live. He might live 80 or more years – only God knows.

Your peaceful presence can make all the difference in the world to a baby and to his/her mother, father, siblings, grandparents, aunts, uncles and cousins. It can make all the difference to their future spouse and children or to others that may help during their time here on earth. God has given this baby gifts and talents which he or she will now be able to develop and share.



This Sunday, October 14, Pope Francis will canonize two new Saints: St. Pope Paul VI and Archbishop Oscar Romero of San Salvador.



"If you want peace, work for justice."


From Paul VI's address to the United Nations in 1965.

Pope Paul VI was born Giovanni Battista Enrico Antonio Maria Montini on Sept. 26, 1897. He led our Catholic Church from 1963 until his death on August 6, 1978. He succeeded Pope John XXIII who died during the Second Vatican Council. Paul VI continued the Council and then implemented its numerous reforms.

Paul VI once wrote that people today listen "more willingly to witnesses than to teachers." He said, "The world calls for, and expects from us, simplicity of life, the spirit of prayer, charity towards all, especially towards the lowly and the poor, obedience and humility, detachment and self-sacrifice."

Pope Paul VI was the first pope to travel outside of Italy; the first to visit the Holy Land; the first to visit and address the United Nations.





Archbishop Oscar Romero, who will become the first Salvadoran saint, was born on August 15, 1917. He was shot and killed while celebrating Mass in a hospital chapel on March 24, 1980, a day after telling an army made up largely of peasants that they were killing their own people. "No soldier is obliged to obey an order that is contrary to the will of God," he preached. Romero was outspoken against military oppression during his country's bloody civil war in the 1980s and worked tirelessly on behalf of the poor and oppressed. His death is considered by the Catholic Church to have been in "odium fidei," meaning in hatred of the faith.

We cannot do everything, and there is a sense of liberation in realizing this. This enables us to do something, and to do it very well. It may be incomplete, but it is a beginning, a step along the way, an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest. We may never see the end results, but that is the difference between the master builder and the worker. We are workers, not master builders, ministers, not messiahs. We are prophets of a future not our own. [Archbishop Oscar Romero]




