**GOSPEL MARK 10:46-52**

As Jesus was leaving Jericho with his disciples and a sizable crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind man, the son of Timaeus, sat by the roadside begging. On hearing that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me." And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he kept calling out all the more, "Son of David, have pity on me." Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." So they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you." He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus. Jesus said to him in reply, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see." Jesus told him, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.

**The Faithful and the Faithful Departed**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I have the best seat in the house. From my chair, every Sunday I get to see all of you seated in the pews, gathered for Mass. I told a parishioner this once and she (politely) disputed me: "But, Father, wouldn't it be best to be gazing upon the crucifix or the Tabernacle ... gazing upon Christ." Ah, I told her, but I am! I am gazing upon Christ ... in all of you, the people, the people of God! You are the body of Christ. You are the temple of the Holy Spirit!

Many times we refer to you, the people, as "the faithful." You'll hear it in the prayers at Mass. It's a good name for you. Because you are faithful ... faithful to God, faithful to Jesus Christ, faithful to this parish and to the Church. You are faithful to the Gospel and to the values of the Kingdom.

This time of year is always a bit more poignant. I am more aware of those among us who are grieving. The Feast of All Saints and All Souls reminds us that there are many in our company who have lost loved ones this year. Their hearts are broken. And yet I see them here, widows and widowers, parents who have lost a child, grandparents who have lost a grandchild, brothers and sisters who have lost a sibling, others who have lost a good friend or neighbor. You are the grieving faithful, but here you come to find hope and comfort in God's Word and the Eucharist.

We name those who have gone before us our faithful departed. And there are so many ... so many women and men who have shared their love and faith with us. Our lives have been enriched by their presence, by their laughter and kindness, by their wisdom and grace. It is good for us to remember them, to give thanks for them, and to celebrate the new life they find in God's full presence.

So, let us the *living faithful* gather on November 1st and 2nd to remember and pray for our *faithful departed*. Surely, we will find Christ present in the tears we share here, just as our loved ones meet Christ face to face where every tear will be wiped away.

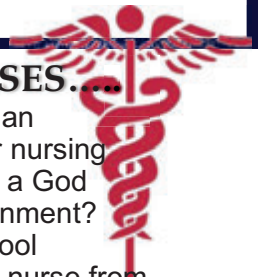

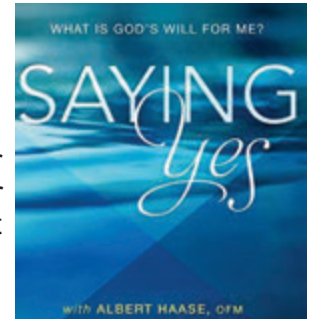


