Respect All Life Every Day

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Every first Sunday of October we take some time to remind us of what is at the core of our Christian morality and Catholic Social Teaching. We need this reminder.

Every human life ... in **every** stage of life ... without exception ... is to be treated with value, is to be honored as a child of God. This is the backbone to all our moral teachings. Never is a human life ... no matter if he or she is in a mother's womb, laying in a nursing home bed, or homeless on a city street ... never is a human life to be treated as an object, an inconvenience, a statistic, a problem to be disposed of.

This consistent ethic of life comes to us from Jesus himself. This is Gospel. Jesus commands us: "love one another the way I love you." How would Jesus love the baby in the womb? How would Jesus love the man in the nursing home bed who can't control his bladder or the woman pushing a cartful of rags and garbage?

Furthermore: how would Jesus love the parents who have just ended their pregnancy? It isn't just the innocent that Jesus loves. God loves **all** human life in **every** stage of life ... when we are at our best *and* when we are at our worst.

"I promise to love you in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health." These are the wedding vows spoken at our altar when a couple is joined in the Sacrament of Matrimony. Husband and wife promise to love each other the way God loves us. In this Sacrament, God gives them the grace to love this way. As a Sacrament, they model for us Christ's love—a love that is unconditional, faithful, forever; a love that goes the extra mile, puts the other first, helps the other grow in happiness and holiness.

We can begin loving this way today. Right now.

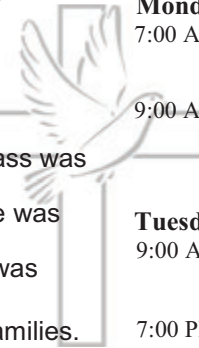
