## The "In" Group

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

A few parishioners who recently attended high school reunions noted that the many cliques which were so prevalent during the teen years have seemed to wither away as classmates grew older. I noticed the very same thing. Age, I suppose, can be an equalizer.

Would that all the things that keep us divided disappear! That goes for the world of faith as well. From the beginning of humanity's walk with God, there have been divisions. Who's in, who's out; who's with us, who's against us. Every religion has known it, including our own.

This is strange since we can find many places in our Scriptures where God teaches us the important lesson of inclusion. We read two of them today — in Numbers 11:25-29 and in our Gospel (Mark 9:38-43,45,47-48). What we learn today (again!) is that we cannot put walls around the movement of the Holy Spirit; that God's love is immense; and that the "in" group, those included in God's embrace, those who "belong" to God, is bigger than we can ever imagine. In fact, according to Jesus, we shouldn't even talk in terms of in and out.

Today at 12 noon, our Caritas Ministry (which is our outreach to those with special needs) celebrates a "sensory friendly Mass." We want everyone to feel included here at St. Joan of Arc. Without exception. That's what "Catholic" means. *Everyone.*

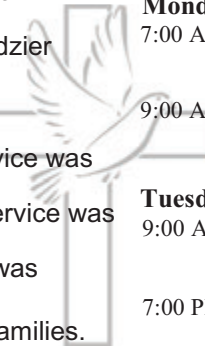
