In the course of his teaching Jesus said to the crowds, "Beware of the scribes, who like to go around in long robes and accept greetings in the marketplaces, seats of honor in synagogues, and places of honor at banquets. They devour the houses of widows and, as a pretext recite lengthy prayers. They will receive a very severe condemnation."

He sat down opposite the treasury and observed how the crowd put money into the treasury. Many rich people put in large sums. A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents. Calling his disciples to himself, he said to them, "Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood."

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Veterans Day came a little early this year to St. Joan of Arc. This past Wednesday, many Vets joined together with parishioners and the students of St. Joan of Arc School for the 9am Daily Mass which was celebrated by Fr. Richard Regan who is himself a veteran of our Air Force. (That's a photo of the Vets in attendance on the bulletin cover ... with one vet missing, Bill Riches, who was at Mass but sat in the back and wasn't able to come up front for the photo.) We blessed the Vets who were present and gave thanks for the dedicated service of all veterans.

Veterans know the meaning of today's Gospel. Jesus points out a poor widow who gives her all, everything she has, to the Temple treasury. She makes an incredible sacrifice for her God. Jesus said she "put in more" than all the other contributors because they gave "from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood."

Put in more. All she had.

As I look at our country's Veterans, this is exactly what I see: men and women who give their *all*, who put in *more* than is expected, who make a great sacrifice for God and country. Some even make the ultimate sacrifice. Their selfless service is a living sermon, an inspiring example of what it means to give of ourselves to others.

I am humbled. And I am oh so grateful. I know you join me in thanking all those who have served in our Armed Forces in any capacity. And I know you pray with me for those who serve today, for those who put their lives on the line, who risk all, who do more than we can imagine to protect our freedom, our right to come here on a Sunday morning and worship God. May God bless them and protect them.

Thank you for your letter of October 18, 2018, sent on behalf of the pastoral council of your parish. I was very happy and grateful to learn of your discussion and to read the questions you raised --- all timely, appropriate and necessary. I agree that such discussions and interactions should continue, considering all the dimensions of contemporary life in the Church.

The sexual abuse of minors by clergy, religious and lay personnel has been nothing short of a nightmare. While I believe our Diocese has initiated and maintains critically important preventive measures throughout its parishes, schools and agencies, past failings are a sad reminder of what has happened without such vigilance.

The next meeting of the nation's bishops will focus on this issue and how bishops must be held accountable for failures.

The victims of sexual abuse of minors remain uppermost in my thoughts, prayers and efforts to reach out. I am also mindful of all our faithful who have likewise been stunned and saddened by recent revelations.

Please express my love and gratitude to your fellow parishioners, especially the pastoral council members. Under the guidance of your wonderful pastor, I hope we will all see better days ahead. May God bless you.


