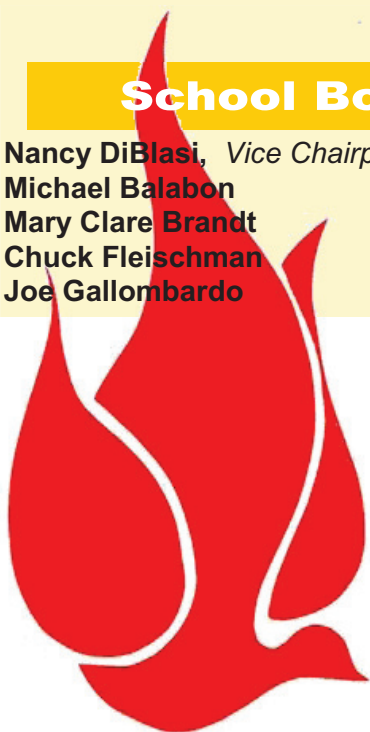

## Getting to Know the King

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

You may be familiar with Pilate's infamous question to question: "What is truth?" In this Sunday's passage from John's Gospel, we hear Pilate ask another question maybe just as important. He asks Jesus, "What have you done?" In other words, what have you done to deserve this kind of treatment, to deserve arrest, to deserve this trial, to deserve such condemnation. What have you done?

How would you answer the question if you were privileged enough to speak for Jesus? What has Jesus done? As his disciples, it is pretty important that we know how to answer this. We need to be able to tell people about Jesus and what he has done. If you know what Jesus has done, you will know about the characteristics of the Kingdom of God.

Jesus asks Pilate (almost as if Pilate is the one on trial), how he has come to know about Jesus. "Do you say this on your own or have others told you about me?" he asks.

How will anyone know Jesus, how will anyone know of his Kingdom, how will anyone know what kind of God we believe in and follow, if we do not tell people about him.

If you feel you need to know more about Jesus ... to meet him again for the first time ... to learn of him as an adult ... don't let the moment pass. Next Sunday is the First of four Sundays of Advent. We begin a new Church year. It's a perfect time to pray, "Help me, Holy Spirit, to know Jesus Christ."

This I know: when I let Jesus be the king of my heart, my heart finds peace. I make better decisions. I treat others better. I find the courage to love the way he loves.

Jesus is still doing amazing things.

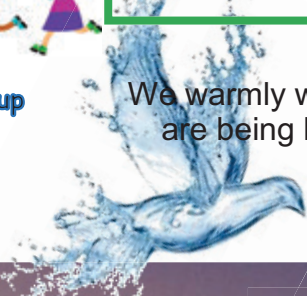


