## GOSPEL MARK 12:28-34

One of the scribes came to Jesus and asked him, "Which is the first of all the commandments?"

## Notes and Happenings

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

1. This Tuesday is Election Day. As Catholic Christians we are called to take seriously our responsibility to be good citizens. Everyone is urged to exercise our freedom and take time this Tuesday to vote.

2. As you can see, last week we broke ground for the new rectory to be built next to the convent! Once the rectory is complete, we can move the priests' residences there and turn the current rectory into a parish center with more meetings spaces and offices. Let's hope for mild weather and most importantly pray for the safety of all involved in the construction.

3. Three years ago our St. Joan of Arc Parish Pastoral Council recommended to me that our parish make a specific, conscious outreach to 1) those touched by addiction; 2) those separated or divorced; and 3) those in the LGBTQ community and their loved ones. Deacon Tom Murphy has been working hard to form groups and ministries to serve this purpose.

I am proud to say in just over two years, we have grown two very strong, successful ministries — "**Accompanying One Another**" (AOA) for those affected by addiction and "**Healing from Divorce.**" And now, on November 15<sup>th</sup>, we will begin offering a monthly Prayer Group called "**One in the Spirit.**" Anyone within the LGBTQ community and their loved ones are invited to join us in prayer on the 15<sup>th</sup>, 7:30pm in the Arc Room.

It is important for everyone to know that we do not begin this new ministry on a whim or as any kind of political statement. Just the opposite. For the past two years, Deacon Tom and a Core Team have been prayerfully discerning, studying and visiting similar prayer groups in other Catholic parishes. The purpose of "One in the Spirit" is not to debate Church teaching, but to provide a welcoming experience for many of our brothers and sisters, our children and grandchildren, who have not always felt included in the Church.

"One in the Spirit" will be a faith-sharing Prayer Group. At each gathering, those present will pray, read the Scriptures and share their faith — always guided by the Holy Spirit with mutual respect for both the Church and for LGBTQ community. Our goal is for everyone to grow in their relationship with our loving God.

As pastor, I feel strongly that we preach and teach that all people are welcome here at St. Joan of Arc and that God's love knows no boundaries. Our parish mission is "**to celebrate, proclaim and share God's love with everyone.**" Without exception. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus sums up the law and the prophets with two commandments: love God and love others as we love ourselves. I see this new prayer group as another step toward fulfilling our mission as a community of disciples of Jesus Christ. Please pray for all whom the Spirit leads into this group, that hearts will be touched deeply by the grace and love of God.

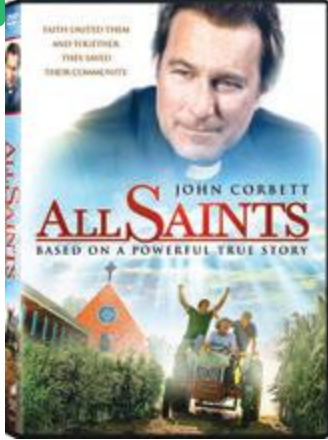

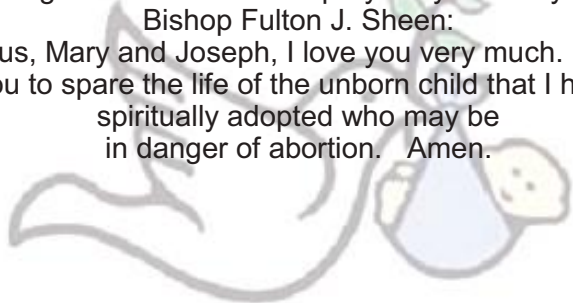
## SPIRITUAL ADOPTION


