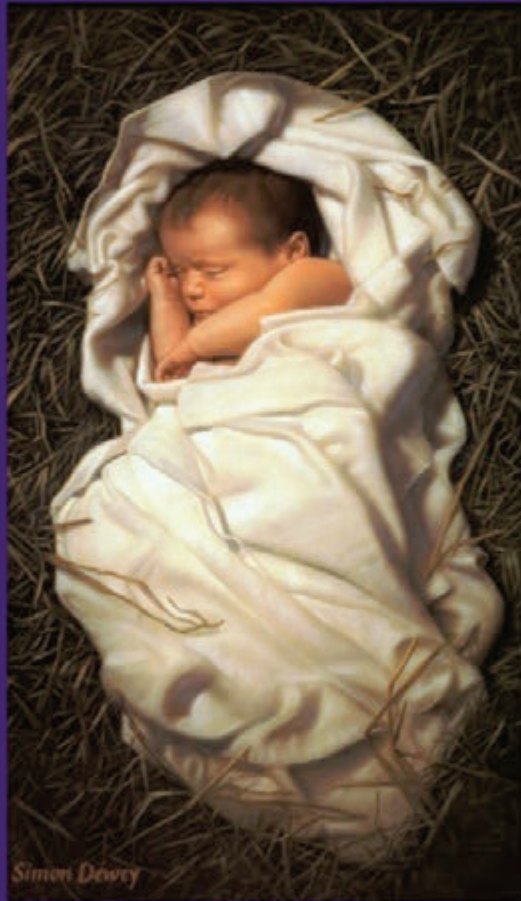

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It is Advent. Again. Break out the four candle wreath and matches. Open a new Advent calendar. Start counting the days and weeks. It's time to prepare not just for the upcoming Feast of Christmas, but also for the end of time, for the Second Coming of Christ. Yes, we believe Christ is coming again and we do not know the day or the hour. Advent, so to speak, holds our hand to the fire and forces us to take action, to get our hearts, our homes and our world ready.

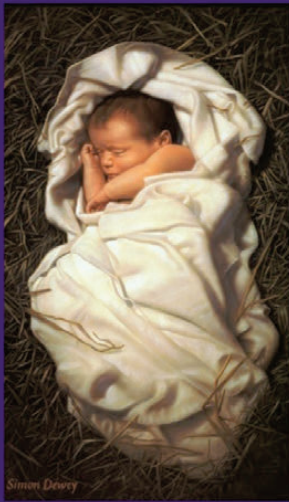

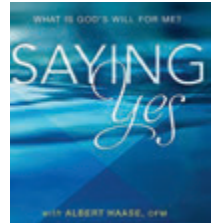

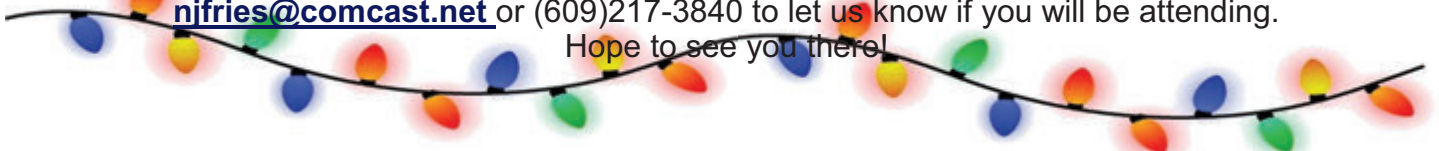

The NJ Assembly is scheduled to vote on December 17th on bill A 1504 which would legalize doctor assisted suicide. Any form of suicide is against both natural law and God's commandments. You can learn about this proposal and its many serious unintended consequences by looking at what the NJ Catholic bishops think about it and then forwarding your comments to your local state lawmakers. To visit the bishop's web site open your browser to nicatholic.org and click "Take Action Now". Finally click the "Contact Your Legislators" block. Fill out the form and click "Send Message."


