BAPTISM OF OUR LORD/2019

You Are Who God Says You Are

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We close the Church's Christmas Season with a feast that remembers and celebrates the baptism of Jesus. Let's be clear: Jesus wasn't baptized for the forgiveness of his sins (he didn't have any to be forgiven), as we are. He didn't need original sin to be washed away, as we do. Instead, Jesus' baptism, as I recently read, "revealed his true nature as God's beloved Son."

In this way, our baptisms are similar to Jesus'.

Of course, Jesus is God's only begotten Son, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, consubstantial with the Father. The Nicene Creed makes it clear that Jesus Christ is unique.

Nonetheless, in our baptism we are reborn as sons and daughters of God. We are joined to Christ. We too are God's sons and daughters. Baptism reveals our true nature. We are claimed for Christ. We are joined to Him.

We've gotten used to calling God our Father. But we might not be so used to hearing God call us "daughter" or "son." That is what we are by virtue of baptism. Think about that for a moment. Bring that to prayer this week. Let it soak in. The next time you come down hard on yourself; the next time you belittle yourself (or another), the next time you doubt your life has purpose of meaning, remember this: you belong to God.


