GOSPEL JOHN 2:1-11

There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there.

Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding.

When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine."

And Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come."

His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you."

Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons.

Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water."

So they filled them to the brim.

Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter."

So they took it.

And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from— although the servers who had drawn the water knew —, the headwaiter called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now."

Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him.

Waiter, there is Wedding in My Soup

Dear parishioners and friends,

Here we are, back in Ordinary Time. This is the year we read from the Gospel of St. Luke. We are hardly out of the gate and ... oops ... we find ourselves in Cana, at a wedding feast, in the Gospel of John.

I'm sure there are great reasons why the experts who put together the Lectionary (Book of Readings) decided to include this story of Jesus and his mother and his friends at a wedding this week. More than likely because this was Jesus' first recorded miracle and we are not just reading about Jesus' early ministry. How wonderful that Jesus' first miracle was at a celebration of love! It says so much about what the rest of His life (and death) would be about!

Whatever the reason it's this week, I am glad we have it today. Following last week's gospel about Jesus' baptism, it gives me a chance to say something about weddings here at St. Joan of Arc.

Baptism is the gateway to all sacraments ... including the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony. I know many people get engaged during the holidays. If you are one of those people, or if your children or grandchildren were recently engaged, or will be, try to gently (always gently) encourage them to consider a Church wedding. Our understanding of what the Sacrament of Marriage is could very likely add a new and beautiful dimension to their relationship. It could draw them closer to God and to one another.

Sometimes people think it is difficult to get married in the Catholic Church. We try to take make it a meaningful and joyful journey of preparation not just for the wedding day, but for all the days *after* the ceremony.

Even if you or your loved ones are planning a destination wedding, or an outdoor wedding, there are options we would love to discuss with them. Please encourage them to give us a call.

Likewise, if you were civilly married and have never had it blessed in the Catholic Church, give us a call. Even if you are already married 1, 5, or 25 years or more, the Sacrament can enrich your life together.

Jesus begins his ministry changing water into wine. He will show us in everything he does how to change hearts and lives for the good ... forever.

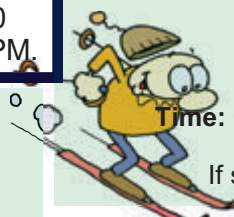

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY & other helpful info

Hopefully we won't have to use the following policy. But in case of inclement weather and you wonder whether Mass or a meeting or program is cancelled or not, this is the rule of thumb we will follow:

MONDAY THRU FRIDAYS:

If EVESHAM TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS are cancelled, Daily Mass and ALL scheduled events and meetings are cancelled (this includes Religious Education classes).

WEEKENDS:

Sunday Mass will only be cancelled in the event that the Governor has issued a State of Emergency permitting only emergency/rescue vehicles on the roads.

If you are unsure, we will leave a message on the phone system and on our parish website, as well as Facebook and Twitter.

This is important: please always use your best judgment and common sense. Trust your instinct: if you think the weather is too bad for you to go out in it, please stay home. Broken hips are not required to follow Jesus.

Related to this: if you are sick or do not feel well, you are certainly not required to come to Mass. You are not committing a sin if you stay home because of illness — in fact, it is more prudent to stay home.

Sign of Peace: If you have a cold or are not feeling well, please share a sign of peace during Mass with a nod of your head, a friendly smile or a wave.

Remember, too: those who are 62 years of age and over are not required to fast one hour before receiving Holy Communion. Nor is anyone who has health issues. ~Thank you!

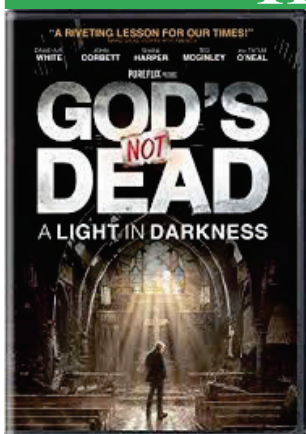

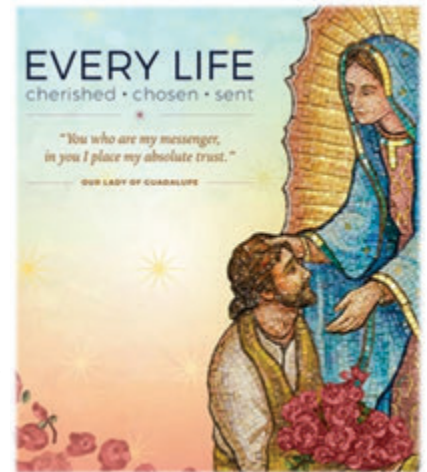

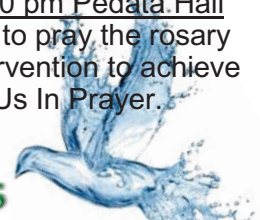
