GOSPEL LUKE 5:1-11

While the crowd was pressing in on Jesus and listening to the word of God, he was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret. He saw two boats there alongside the lake; the fishermen had disembarked and were washing their nets. Getting into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, he asked him to put out a short distance from the shore.

Then he sat down and taught the crowds from the boat. After he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch."

Simon said in reply, "Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets."

When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish and their nets were tearing. They signaled to their partners in the other boat to come to help them. They came and filled both boats so that the boats were in danger of sinking.

When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at the knees of Jesus and said, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man."

For astonishment at the catch of fish they had made seized him and all those with him, and likewise James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners of Simon.

Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men."

When they brought their boats to the shore, they left everything and followed him.

There is Another Way

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It used to be that even those in our country who supported abortion would speak of it in terms of "safe, legal and *rare*." I don't hear "rare" anymore and that is very telling of where we have come as a nation.

In a recent article published in the Philadelphia Inquirer (posted online January 18), two women wrote of their experiences with abortion. One wrote: "Abortion is basic health care and should remain safe, legal and funded." No mention of rare.

Furthermore, nowhere in the article does she speak of how her health was threatened by the pregnancy. Instead, she says she was twenty years old, working multiple jobs and putting herself through college. By her own admission, her pregnancy was more inconvenient than life-threatening.

If we know anything about Jesus, we know he never treated anyone — especially the most vulnerable, especially the voiceless and powerless — as an inconvenience, as "a problem" to get rid of. Who is more vulnerable, voiceless and powerless than an unborn child?

Our laws — including now the one recently passed in New York — clearly have not made us more compassionate, more respectful of human life. And isn't that what laws should do? In a recent homily Bishop David O'Connell quoted Thomas Jefferson who said: "The care of human life and happiness, and not their destruction, is the first and only object of good government."

Jesus always shows us another way, the better way to treat one another. Jesus shows us how to treat each other as persons made in the image and likeness of God.

Recently one of our parishioners told me the story of how as a teenager she became pregnant. Of course she was frightened and confused. She (and her boyfriend who later became her husband) chose to have the baby. They also chose to let their son be adopted. Thirty-eight years later, through some remarkable circumstances, she and her husband have been reunited with their son who is married with children of his own. This is not a sad story. This is a story of courage and sacrifice, love and life.

Adoption is not a dirty word.

My best friend is adopted and everyday prays in thanksgiving for two women: one who gave him life and one who raised him.

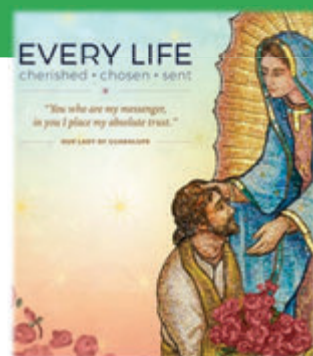

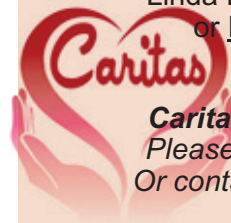

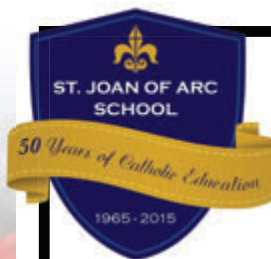
