Behold, your reward will be great in heaven.

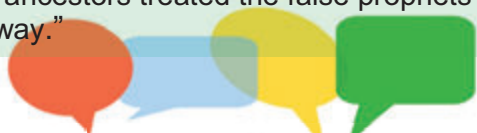

SIXTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME/2019

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

By the time you read this, most of you will be well aware that last Wednesday all five Dioceses of New Jersey published lists of clergy who have been credibly accused of the sexual abuse of a minor. A credible accusation “is one that after a review of available and relevant information, there is reason to believe the allegation is true.”

In the words of our bishop, David O’Connell: “Our first responsibility must always be to those who have endured sexual abuse as minors and the release of these names is our effort to express acceptance of their allegations as credible and to indicate the status of their alleged abusers. I greatly admire and respect the courage of those victims who have come forward. It is our hope that the public presentation of these names will contribute to healing the awful wounds that victims have endured at the hands of some clergy.”

You know that Fathers Jorge, Michael and myself have spoken often from our pulpit regarding this terrible chapter in the life of the Church. We have expressed our anger, sadness and distress. We feel no less passionately about it today. Perhaps even more so, since we know men who are named on this list. You may know some as well. I must, as pastor of St. Joan of Arc, tell you that two of the priests on the list served in our parish many years ago: Father Brendan Williams (from 1965-1970) and Fr. Francis McGrath (as a transitional deacon from 1978-79). The complete list can be seen on the Diocese of Trenton’s website.

Here at St. Joan of Arc, we remain committed to the safety of our children. **All** priests, deacons, sisters, as well as **all** employees and lay persons who volunteer in the school, religious education program, WINGS youth ministry, are fingerprinted and have background checks, as well as any and all lay persons who have contact with young persons (Children’s Liturgy of the Word (KidsLIT), for example). We are all trained in a program called “Protecting God’s Children.”

Since 2002, every diocese in the USA abides by the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, a comprehensive set of procedures for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy. Accordingly, the Diocese of Trenton reports any allegation of sexual abuse to the appropriate law enforcement agencies.

If you have been sexually abused as a minor by a member of the clergy or anyone representing the Catholic Church, or if you know of someone who was, you can report that abuse through the diocesan **ABUSE HOTLINE: 1-888-296-2965** or via e-mail at abuseline@dioceseoftrenton.org.

As always, if you have questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me or Fr. Jorge or Fr. Michael. We welcome the opportunity to talk with you. Let’s continue to join together in prayer for the victims of any kind of abuse.

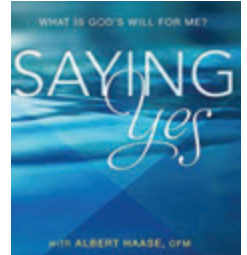

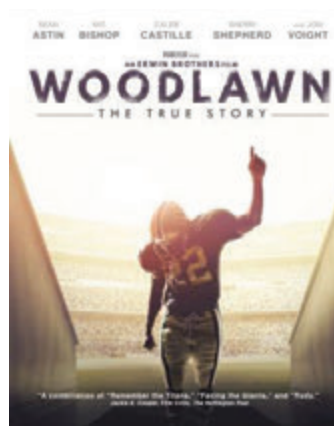

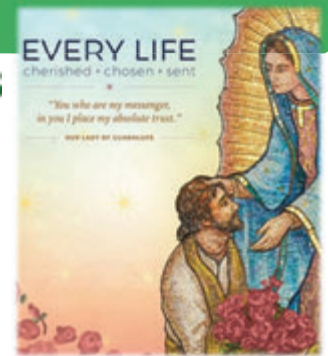
