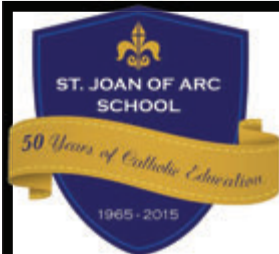

### GOSPEL LUKE 4:21-30

Jesus began speaking in the synagogue, saying: "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing."

And all spoke highly of him and were amazed at the gracious words that came from his mouth.

They also asked, "Isn't this the son of Joseph?"

He said to them, "Surely you will quote me this proverb, 'Physician, cure yourself,' and say, 'Do here in your native place the things that we heard were done in Capernaum.'"

And he said, "Amen, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own native place. Indeed, I tell you, there were many widows in Israel in the days of Elijah when the sky was closed for three and a half years and a severe famine spread over the entire land.

It was to none of these that Elijah was sent, but only to a widow in Zarephath in the land of Sidon.

Again, there were many lepers in Israel during the time of Elisha the prophet; yet not one of them was cleansed, but only Naaman the Syrian."

When the people in the synagogue heard this, they were all filled with fury. They rose up, drove him out of the town, and led him to the brow of the hill on which their town had been built, to hurl him down headlong.

But Jesus passed through the midst of them and went away.

## *Back to Reality*

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This Sunday's Gospel passage picks up exactly where we left off last Sunday. We are in the fourth chapter of Luke, early in the ministry of Jesus. Jesus has just read from the prophet Isaiah. He has told them, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." In other words, Jesus fulfills the passage. Jesus is the anointed one of God, the Messiah. In one breath the people, we are told, are "amazed at the gracious words that came from his mouth." In the next breath they can't believe this is Jesus, the kid they saw grow up down the street, Joseph and Mary's son. Ten minutes after being amazed they are ready to throw him off a cliff.

It's a big dose of reality for us. Not everyone loved Jesus. That's obvious, you say. Jesus was crucified. But long before he was condemned to death, folks were rankled by what he preached and taught. In this very passage, for instance, Jesus tells the people (buckle up!) that foreigners will welcome the Messiah more readily than they. No wonder they are "filled with fury."

Our second reading today is from Paul's famous passage on love. "Love is patient, love is kind." It is beautiful. I'm sure you've heard it at a wedding or two. But it isn't meant to be etched on a Hallmark card and read only on the wedding day. It is meant to be lived everyday after the wedding; in other words, in real life. And not only married people. Anyone who believes in Jesus is called to love this way. It shouldn't be the exception. It's the rule.

That's the reality.

And that's why we need each other. That's why we need Church and a parish. That's why we need Scripture and Mass and the Eucharist. That's why we need daily prayer and confession and all the Sacraments. That's why we need to gather in small groups to talk to each other, to learn from each other and to challenge each other.

Without Church, without a community of faith, we will paint a portrait of Jesus that suits us, makes us comfortable, makes us feel good. That is not always the best thing for us.

"Lord Jesus: open our eyes and ears and heart to receive your message as You mean it, not as I wish it to be!"

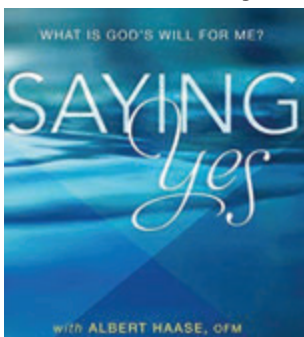

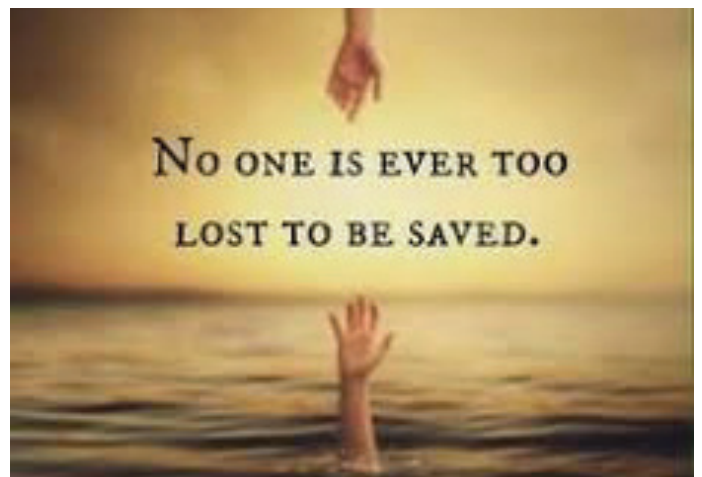
