FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT/2019 INTO THE DESERT

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Into the desert. That's where we go on the first Sunday of every Lent. Ah, so Lent wants to move us to a place we might not be inclined to go. After all, who wants to go to a desert? Florida, yes. A resort on an island, absolutely. An empty, dry, water-less desert? Nope.

If we are to battle our deepest temptations, those things — thoughts, habits, actions, decisions, perhaps even relationships — that bring us down, that hurt and harm us, that keep us from being fully human, fully the person God intends us to be, then we must move in a new direction, to a new place, one that we might not wish to go. It may not be a physical move; it may be an interior one — aren't they perhaps the most difficult moves to make? To go to a new place in one's head or heart.

In light of this, I want to invite you to our Parish Mission this week. I want to invite and encourage especially those who have not come before to a Mission. A Parish Mission is a time for us to reflect and pray together, to hear a common message as we begin our Lenten pilgrimage. If you have never come before, take the challenge to move to a different place. I know the time you give to the Mission — this Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings at 7:30pm — will be blessed. You will be blessed.

The good news is that we do not do this "desert-thing" alone. We go it together as a faith community. In finding Christ among us, we learn to become Christ for one another. And isn't this the goal and dream and hope of every Lent?

A Late, Lost Lent?

Lent comes late this year — almost as late as it can get.
Easter is late, too — April 21!
(The latest Easter can be is April 25 and that won't happen until 2038!!)

The word "Lent" comes from an old English word that means "springtime." This year a big chunk of Lent will be in spring.

With the coming of spring, it might be easy for Lent to get "lost." As we tiptoe through tulips, we might be tempted to skip right past Lent.

Let's take Lent one day at a time.

Lent is 40 days long on purpose. Conversion takes times. Letting go of ego and sin takes time. Embracing the Good News of the Gospel takes time, too. Letting God's mercy sink in and take deep root needs time and patience.

Don't rush your Lent. Try not to scurry through your prayers and sacrifices. Take your time doing good deeds of mercy and charity. Take care to notice people you are with; pay attention to all that is going on deep within yourself and all that is going on around you.

Growing closer to Jesus needs time. Walk with Jesus this Lent, don't run. Don't hurry Jesus.

If we do this, instead of getting lost, Lent can make a lasting impression upon our hearts and minds. We will be renewed and ready to celebrate Easter with a joy that can last forever!

the field of word and sacrament: the intersection of symbolic activity and language as

it creates insights into the

Christian proclamation of grace. Central to this work is a fascination with the power of liturgy and preaching in the transformation of the human heart.


