Jesus told his disciples a parable, "Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit?"

No disciple is superior to the teacher; but when fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher.

Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own?

How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove that splinter in your eye,' when you do not even notice the wooden beam in your own eye?

You hypocrite! Remove the wooden beam from your eye first; then you will see clearly to remove the splinter in your brother's eye.

Can a Blind Person Lead a Blind Person?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The name of this painting is "Gassed," which is a very large oil painting completed exactly 100 years ago, in March 1919

by John Singer Sargent. It depicts the aftermath of a mustard gas attack during the First World War, with a line of wounded soldiers



walking towards a dressing station. The painting was voted as the picture of the year by the Royal Academy of Arts in 1919 and it is now held by the Imperial War Museum, in London.

The painting provides a powerful testimony of the effects of war and chemical weapons. It is also an invitation to think about the blind leaders that we follow and the horrible consequences of poor leadership.

How often do we think we know better, judging other people's actions, without knowing ourselves? In the gospel Jesus warns us from blind guides and invites us to consider this: if I have to guide other people -children, relatives, coworkers- can I see well enough to show them the way? Am I leading others to God or am I leading them away?

Let us turn our eyes to God and, trusting in his leadership, let us ask Him to make our hearts like His.

Our parish mission will be held this lent on the 11th, 12th & 13th of March and will include morning & evening sessions. The morning sessions will follow the 9am Mass and the topic will be the Holy Father's call to holiness in today's world.

The topic of the evening sessions will be taken from this year's Lenten theme: "The Work of Forgiveness". The mission will begin each night at

7:30pm in the church (except for Tuesday, March 12th – when it will follow the 7pm mass). On Wednesday evening we will have refreshments following the talk in Pedata Hall. Please feel free to bring some goodies to share and drop them off in Pedata Hall when you arrive.

Our mission director this year is Fr. Richard Fragomeni.

Fr. Fragomeni is a presbyter of the Diocese of Albany, NY and has been a member of the catholic theological union faculty since 1990. His teaching involves him in roman catholic theology, interpretation theory & poetry. His current work is in the field of word and sacrament: the intersection of symbolic activity and

language as it creates insights into the Christian proclamation of grace.

Central to this work is a fascination with the power of liturgy and preaching in the transformation of the human heart.

Where and to what is God calling you to change – to be firm, steadfast and devoted to the work of the Lord?

What might this preoccupation tell you about the wooden beam in your own eye?

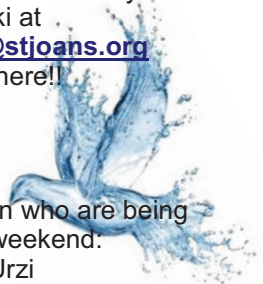

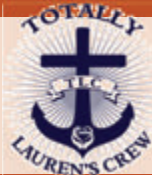

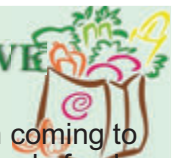
