GOSPEL JOHN 20:1-9

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him."

So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in.

When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place.

Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed.

For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

"It is not only the empty tomb. Now... The Christ... is with you." Small Group Discussion Questions:

- 1- In all the events leading up to the crucifixion of Jesus, which one in particular opens your eyes to how much God cares about and loves you?
- 2- At the empty tomb the Beloved Disciple believes but does not yet understand. What mysteries of faith do you lack understanding?
- 3- In what way is God calling you to strengthen your belief so that you can be His disciple?
- 4- How are you being called to live deeper in this mystery?

EASTER SUNDAY/2019 EASTER SUNDAY: ALREADY (OR FINALLY) HERE!!

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Why does it always seem Easter comes around quickly. So many people in the last week have said to me, "Wow! Can't believe it's already Easter." I get it. I feel the same way. And yet, this year, Easter is just about as late as it can get.

Perhaps we feel it came quickly because that's the nature of time these days: fast! One day passes in the blink of an eye. Forty blinks and Lent is over and here we are: another Easter.

But we don't want this to be just another Easter. We want this Easter to be as transformative — as life-changing — as the first Easter. To help us do this, the Church gives us an Easter **Season** — a full fifty days (or blinks) of celebrating the Risen Jesus in our midst.

Perhaps we can begin each day this Easter Season as if we have just discovered the empty tomb — Christ is risen! Everyday, then, begins with excitement and joy! Each day full of hope and surprise, our eyes wide open, ready to meet the risen Christ everywhere we go!

Perhaps we can defy the speed of time by taking our time in prayer ... slow down those Hail Marys and Our Fathers. Take a few extra minutes in prayer.

And take slow walks. On the first Easter Sunday two disciples began a seven mile walk to Emmaus, deep in conversation (wow! a seven mile chat!).

Bring the Gospel home. In each bulletin we publish the Sunday Gospel. Perhaps it could be read before dinner, or after, and briefly discussed. Ask each other: "What did you hear in the passage?" "What stands out?" "How did it make you feel?" "What does it make you want to do?"

Whether you feel it got here quickly, or took its time, Easter wants to last a lifetime ... and beyond!




