GOSPEL LUKE JN 8:1-11

Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. But early in the morning he arrived again in the temple area, and all the people started coming to him, and he sat down and taught them.

Then the scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery and made her stand in the middle. They said to him, "Teacher, this woman was caught in the very act of committing adultery. Now in the law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. So what do you say?"

They said this to test him, so that they could have some charge to bring against him.

Jesus bent down and began to write on the ground with his finger.

But when they continued asking him, he straightened up and said to them, "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." Again he bent down and wrote on the ground. And in response, they went away one by one, beginning with the elders. So he was left alone with the woman before him.

Then Jesus straightened up and said to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?"

She replied, "No one, sir."

Then Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin any more."

"Go and Sin No More ~ Change Your Future" Small Group Discussion Questions:

We are called to forgive - Consider the Lord's Prayer.

- 1- Jesus bends and writes in the dirt. Was he giving them time to think? Do we need time?
- 2- How have you experienced giving and receiving mercy in your life?
- 3- How has your practice of forgiving changed in these past five weeks?
- 4- Has it enriched your relationship with God?
- 5- Has the word Mercy this Lent taken on a new meaning?

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT/2019 DROP THE STONES

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We've been there. Maybe not on *that* street. Maybe not *that* sin. But her story is our story.

It's usually called "the woman caught in adultery." It's our Gospel this week, again from St. Luke, again amazing in its detail and in its ability to grab us by the throat and get us involved.

The woman doesn't have a name. (By the way, she is not Mary Magdalene, as is often mistakenly thought.)



She has sinned. (By the way, so has the man she was with.) Jesus faces a crowd ready to pass judgment. He takes a deep breath, goes down to the dirt and scribbles in it. (By the way, we are not told what he writes

or even exactly why he does it.)

We've been there.

We've all sinned. Big. We've all hurled stones at ourselves, putting ourselves down, condemning ourselves, maybe even hating ourselves. We've also thrown stones at others because of their sins, real or gossiped about enough to sound real.

Jesus has been there too. With us. To welcome us. To embrace us. To look us in the eyes. Not to condemn. No, to ease the stones out of our hands. To show us another way to deal with the sin and the effects of it. To help us begin anew.

Next week is Palm Sunday. There may be no better gospel story than the one we hear today to lead us into the holiest of weeks and the three most important days of our year and our lives. This Holy Week, let Jesus look you in the eyes. Let Jesus speak to you. Let Jesus forgive you and set you free. Let Jesus love you.


