GOSPEL JOHN 21:1-14

At that time, Jesus revealed himself to his disciples at the Sea of Tiberias. He revealed himself in this way. Together were Simon Peter, Thomas called Didymus, Nathanael from Cana in Galilee, Zebedee's sons, and two others of his disciples. Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We also will come with you." So they went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. When it was already dawn, Jesus was standing on the shore; but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus. Jesus said to them, "Children, have you caught anything to eat?" They answered him, "No." So he said to them, "Cast the net over the right side of the boat and you will find something." So they cast it, and were not able to pull it in because of the number of fish. So the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord." When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he tucked in his garment, for he was lightly clad, and jumped into the sea. The other disciples came in the boat, for they were not far from shore, only about a hundred yards, dragging the net with the fish. When they climbed out on shore, they saw a charcoal fire with fish on it and bread. Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish you just caught." So Simon Peter went over and dragged the net ashore full of one hundred fifty-three large fish. Even though there were so many, the net was not torn. Jesus said to them, "Come, have breakfast." And none of the disciples dared to ask him, "Who are you?" because they realized it was the Lord. Jesus came over and took the bread and gave it to them, and in like manner the fish. This was now the third time Jesus was revealed to his disciples after being raised from the dead.

4. How did you find the strength (and the time) to make the effort to grow closer to Christ Jesus?
5. Do you have the sight – the courage – the will – to point others to Jesus?
6. Will you help them along the way?

SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Next Sunday the Church around the world is asked to pray for vocations. It is no secret that we are in great need of priests. People have been talking about "a priest shortage" since I was ordained 33 years ago. (I will share more thoughts of this next week.) While here on this side of Marlton, we haven't yet felt the full impact of fewer priests (we have indeed been blessed!), we are not immune to "the shortage."

This past week, Bishop David O'Connell announced changes in priest personnel. Included in these changes is our own Associate Pastor, Father Michael DeSaye. Beginning on July 1, Fr. Michael will be the fulltime Chaplain at Jersey Shore Medical Center in Neptune, NJ.

As you know, Fr. Michael has been with us a very short time, only since his ordination last June! We are truly just beginning to get to know him and he us. Please keep Fr. Michael in your prayers during this time of transition. Moving from one parish to another, beginning a new ministry, is never easy. In the weeks ahead, please be sure to thank Fr. Michael for the ministry he has shared with us here. Pray also for him as he assumes the role of chaplain. I am confident that his many gifts and deep spirituality will be a tremendous source of comfort and hope to the patients of Jersey Shore Medical Center.

We will announce very soon the date of a farewell celebration when we can give Fr. Michael our gratitude and blessing.

If this Medical Center sounds vaguely familiar, it's because our good friend, Fr. Leon Buni — may he rest in peace! — was also sent to this very hospital only last year. (It is a very large facility which is why the Bishop would like a priest there fulltime.) Fr. Michael will live in residence at Holy Innocents Parish where he will reside with the pastor, Fr. Todd Carter. Again, a familiar name to us — Fr. Todd served here at St. Joan of Arc, as a Transitional Deacon, more than a few years back. Not only that, but those of you with really good memories will recall Fr. Mike Wallack also went from our parish to Holy Innocents. Is there a theme here?

Inevitably, I know many people will ask me, "Who is the Bishop sending to replace Fr. Michael?" Honestly, this is always a rather uncomfortable question. We just announce a priest is leaving and one of the first things people want to know is, "Who's next?" Anyway, this year you won't have to ask. The answer is simple.

No one.

And this year there will be no priests ordained for the Diocese of Trenton. None in 2020, either.

That's why next week we are praying for vocations.
