SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER/2019 ANSWER TO <u>HIS</u> PRAYER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

What does Jesus pray for when Jesus prays?

Throughout the Gospels, we hear of many instances when Jesus took time to pray. Except for the night before his crucifixion (in the Garden of Gethsemane), and also on the occasion of the death of his friend, Lazarus, we don't hear what Jesus actually says in his prayers.

This Sunday we do. In Chapter 17 of John's Gospel, verse 20, we read: "Lifting up his eyes to heaven, *Jesus prayed, saying* ..." We hear Jesus pray for his disciples, those who were present with him and those who would later believe and follow (that's us!). Yes, Jesus is praying for us!

As the prayer continues, we discover something very interesting. Jesus does not pray for our good health and long life. Jesus does not pray that we do not know suffering or pain or sorrow. Jesus does not pray for our safety and security. Jesus does not pray that we might be perfect disciples.

What does he pray for?

Jesus prays that we "may all be one." Jesus prays for our unity. What are we doing — in our family, community, parish, country, world and Church — to help answer Jesus' prayer?


