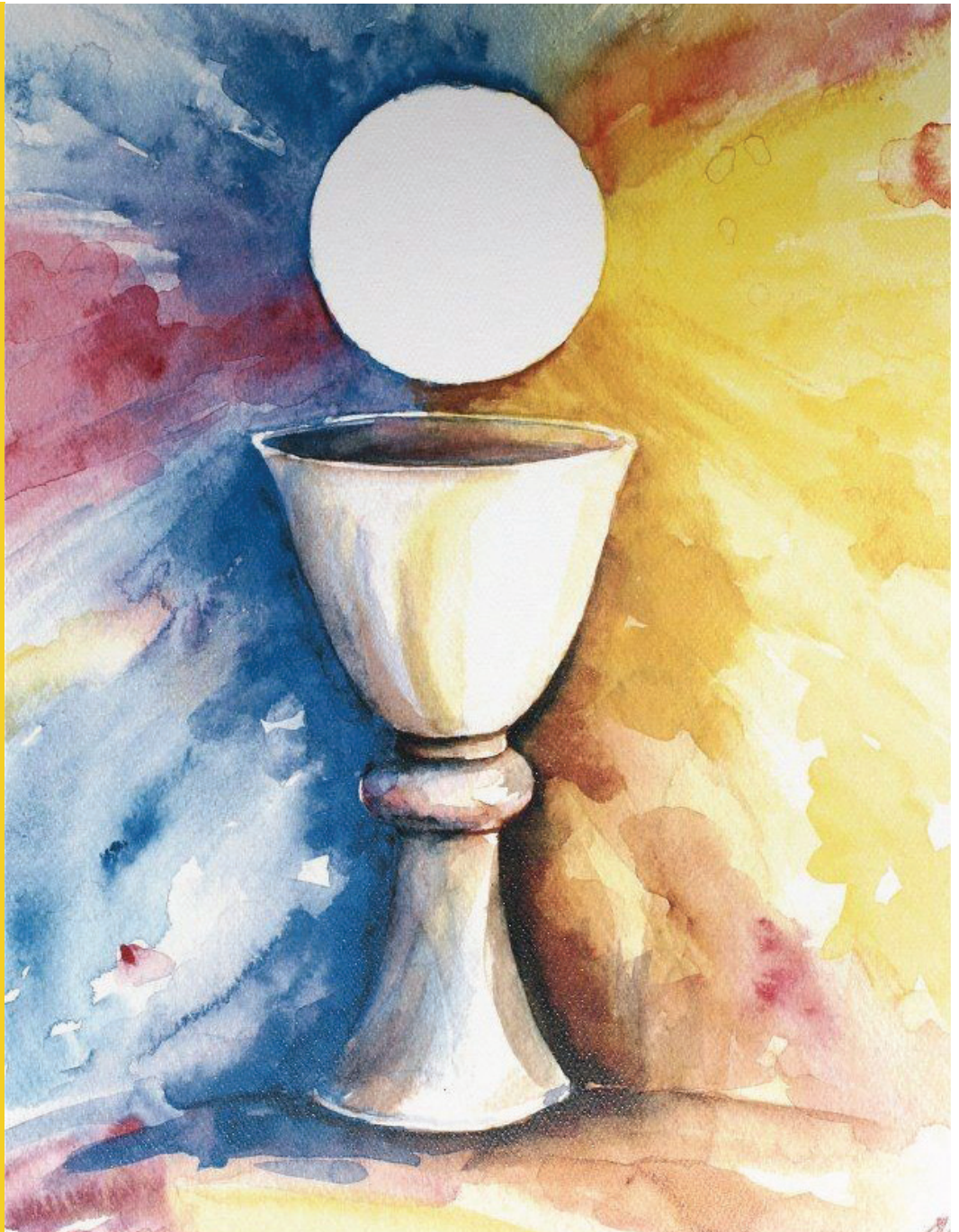

GOSPEL LUKE 9:11B-17

Jesus spoke to the crowds about the kingdom of God, and he healed those who needed to be cured.

As the day was drawing to a close, the Twelve approached him and said, "Dismiss the crowd so that they can go to the surrounding villages and farms and find lodging and provisions; for we are in a deserted place here."

He said to them, "Give them some food yourselves."

They replied, "Five loaves and two fish are all we have, unless we ourselves go and buy food for all these people." Now the men there numbered about five thousand.

Then he said to his disciples, "Have them sit down in groups of about fifty." They did so and made them all sit down. Then taking the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, he said the blessing over them, broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd.

They all ate and were satisfied. And when the leftover fragments were picked up, they filled twelve wicker baskets.



Small Group Faith Sharing Questions

- 1) How does Jesus call you to feed those who experience hunger, whether physical or spiritual?
- 2) How do you see the Eucharist pattern of "taking, blessing, breaking and giving" in your own life?
- 3) In the Gospel, Jesus' disciples act out of scarcity, but Jesus provides abundantly. What resource in your life provokes the feeling of scarcity? Is there a way that you might see Jesus abundant care in this experience?
- 4) Which experience in the context of the mass communicates Jesus presence to you most strongly - The Word, Eucharist, the Priest, the Assembly, Singing, Symbols - which one? Or is there another?

MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST/CORPUS CHRISTI/2019 AN IMPORTANT WORD OF CAUTION

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I have good news and bad news. First, the bad:

There is a *nationwide scam* going on in which deceitful people pose as a pastor of a church. Unfortunately, we in Marlton have been affected by it in the past and again recently.

Here's how it works: Sinister people send a text and/or email to parishioners. The text or email says it is coming from me (though they are *not* using my email address or my phone number). In my name they ask the parishioner to purchase and send gift cards (this last time around they asked for itunes) to me so I can give them to needy people (the last thing in the world needy people need are itune gift cards!). But they do not ask the parishioner to bring the cards to the rectory; they ask them to send a picture of the gift card and its pin number.

THIS IS A SCAM. I will NEVER ask you, via text or email, to purchase gift cards for needy people. The old rule applies: if it smells fishy, it's fishy. Don't believe it. If you have **any** questions about **any** correspondence you receive that is (supposedly) from me or anyone from our parish or school, call us. Before you do anything, especially if money is involved, call us. Get the right information. And then call the police and report the scam. Give the police the email address and the phone number of the one who contacted you.

I am so sorry that people are being deceived like this. I am so sorry I have to devote a column of the bulletin to this, especially on the Feast of Corpus Christi — the Body and Blood of Christ. But, as I said at the beginning, there is good news:

This scam was dreamed up exactly because people of faith — people like you — tend to be generous and kind and always willing to help. (People of faith can also be gullible — that's not so good news). Thank you for your good heart. Thank you for caring about people who are hurting. Thank you for trying to live like the Christ you receive in the Eucharist. Don't let evil people strip you of your kindness and generosity. Instead, as Jesus said, when dealing with the "snakes" in the world, we must be as "wise as serpents." But, finally, always remember: the Body of Christ is stronger than evil and hatred. Love wins. God wins.

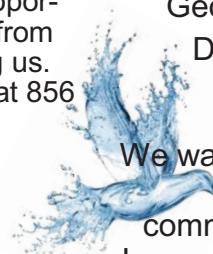

A MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP

New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program opens June 15

As had been announced in February of this year, the Diocese of Trenton – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as minors, were sexually abused by a priest or deacon of the Diocese. The IVCP will be open to claims beginning June 15.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros. Mr. Feinberg was the plan administrator for the federal 9/11 victim compensation program, as well as the Boston Marathon bombing compensation program.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and will operate independently of the Diocese or any Church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP will have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the Protocol for submitting a claim.

Anyone who was sexually victimized as a minor by a priest or deacon of the Diocese is strongly encouraged to participate in the IVCP. The Diocese also asks that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to pass along this information to the victim so that he or she is aware of the IVCP.
