### **GOSPEL LUKE 10:38-42**

Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples." He said to them, "When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread and forgive us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us, and do not subject us to the final test."

And he said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend to whom he goes at midnight and says, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread, for a friend of mine has arrived at my house from a journey and I have nothing to offer him,' and he says in reply from within, 'Do not bother me; the door has already been locked and my children and I are already in bed. I cannot get up to give you anything.' I tell you, if he does not get up to give the visitor the loaves because of their friendship, he will get up to give him whatever he needs because of his persistence.

"And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. What father among you would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish? Or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg? If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

## **PRAYING HIS PRAYER**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

How many times will we pray it in a lifetime? We pray it every Mass, whether the Mass be a Sunday or daily one, a wedding or funeral. No doubt you pray it every day as part of your morning and evening prayers, in your rosary, perhaps as you drive to work, or before a big test at school.

It's the Lord's Prayer. More commonly called "The Our Father."

You teach your children and grandchildren this prayer. It is part of our Christian lexicon. It binds us together as a Christian family ... it's the one prayer Catholics, Protestants, Orthodox — all of us — know.

Except I am noticing it is not prayed as much. Once even those persons who were not as active in their church attendance still knew this prayer and would join in the praying of it at weddings and funerals or when we gathered at the sick bed of a loved one or in a cemetery. But today, not so much. I don't see lips moving. I don't hear the cascade of voices I once heard.

Of course, it does not necessarily mean people are not praying, but I wonder. Does prayer go the way of faith? I mean, why pray if you don't believe? And yet, fervently I hope (and pray) I am wrong.

This is the prayer *Jesus* gave us. Some argue He didn't mean it to be a prayer, but a model for praying. Either way, these are still *His* words. What better prayer can we make than one Jesus prayed?

This week, if unsure if your children or grandchildren know it, why not take a moment to teach it. And, of course, there is no better way to teach prayer than by actually praying. It certainly wouldn't hurt any of us to pray a little more often.

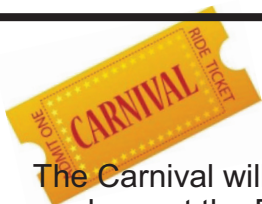
