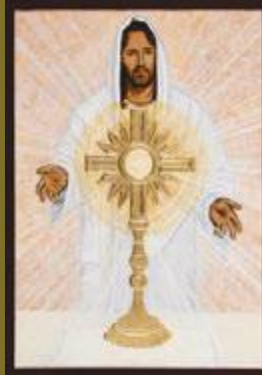

It certainly can't hurt to give God thanks two weeks in a row for the blessing of freedom. We are all too aware of how freedom can be taken for granted, as well as how sometimes it can be subtly lost or overtly taken away.

BURLINGTON COUNTY DIOCESAN RESPECT LIFE NEWS

The NJ Legislature is now processing a package of healthcare bills (A5508/S3804) which could have a grave impact on religious liberty if enacted. These bills will expand insurance coverage for abortion inducing drugs and eliminate the religious employers' exemption contained in New Jersey public law. By removing the religious employers' exemption, Catholic parishes, schools and other religious institutions would be forced to provide insurance coverage for abortion inducing drugs.
