GOSPEL LUKE 14:25-33

Great crowds were traveling with Jesus, and he turned and addressed them, "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion?

Otherwise, after laying the foundation and finding himself unable to finish the work the onlookers should laugh at him and say, 'This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish.' Or what king marching into battle would not first sit down and decide whether with ten thousand troops he can successfully oppose another king advancing upon him with twenty thousand troops? But if not, while he is still far away, he will send a delegation to ask for peace terms. In the same way, anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple."

Figuring Out God

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

"Who can conceive what the Lord intends?" That's the question asked by the author of the Book of Wisdom. In other words, who knows the mind of God?

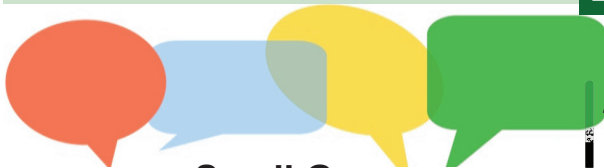
Simple answer. No one. None of us can say we know God's mind or what the Lord intends. Heck, we aren't all that good at figuring out other people's minds! And sometimes we can't even figure our own out!!

That's why we have Jesus. Jesus does know what God intends. Christ Jesus is the Son of God, the Second Person in the Blessed Trinity. As we say in our Creed: He is consubstantial with the Father. Christ is "one in being with" God the Father. That's why it is essential to know Jesus.

This might sound too theological or too philosophical and not very practical. Let me make it practical: have you ever asked yourself or someone else, "What is the will of God?" This is like asking: What does God want ... for me ... for others ... for the world. The fact is we do ask that question many times during a lifetime, usually during very troubling and difficult circumstances.

Jesus knows the will of God. Jesus knows what God wants for us and for our world. We need to know Jesus.

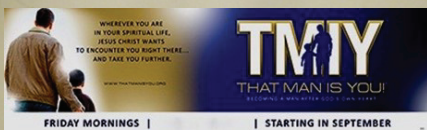

A New Program Coming to St. Joan of Arc in October 10th
