27th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME **DESPAIR DOESN'T HAVE TO WIN**

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

His name sounds kind of kooky. Habakkuk. As a prophet, he doesn't get nearly the press as Isaiah gets, or Jeremiah. (In the seminary, I could only remember his name as "Have a cookie.")

But Habakkuk deserves our attention. He lived at a time in ancient Israel's history when things were not going so well. He could see that the country was on the brink of disaster. We hear that in today's first reading: How long, O LORD? I cry for help but you do not listen! I cry out to you, 'Violence!' but you do not intervene." (Habakkuk 1:2-3)

Can you hear the near despair in his voice?

Read on! Because the message does not end there — in despair. There is a vision, Habakkuk says. There is a vision of something greater ... something greater that we belong to, something greater that belongs to us! (Habakkuk 2:2-4)

This something greater is **God's promise** ... and as we will see in Jesus Christ ...

God's presence!

The vision requires patience and patience is only possible when we trust, when we have faith. And faith, as Jesus tells us can move mountains.

Faith can do the impossible.

Faith can move us from the brink of disaster.
Faith can help us find a way out of darkness. Faith can move a mountain of despair and fill us with hope. Even joy!
