GOSPEL LUKE 20:27-38

Some Sadducees, those who deny that there is a resurrection, came forward and put this question to Jesus, saying, "Teacher, Moses wrote for us, If someone's brother dies leaving a wife but no child, his brother must take the wife and raise up descendants for his brother. Now there were seven brothers; the first married a woman but died childless. Then the second and the third married her, and likewise all the seven died childless. Finally the woman also died. Now at the resurrection whose wife will that woman be? For all seven had been married to her." Jesus said to them, "The children of this age marry and remarry; but those who are deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage. They can no longer die, for they are like angels; and they are the children of God because they are the ones who will rise. That the dead will rise even Moses made known in the passage about the bush. when he called out 'Lord, ' the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob; and he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive."

Small Group Faith Sharing Questions

- The Sadducees questioned Jesus about the resurrection which they did not accept as reality – and so asked Jesus a question – what is it we question?
- 2) Jesus tells us in this gospel that God is not God of the dead, but of the living for to Him, all are alive. How do you experience this in your own life of faith?
- 3) The question asked of Jesus is not about who will live with God and who will suffer eternal punishment – that question came later. It is now a question for us, personally? How do you stand with God?

32nd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME **MORE TO COME**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

You will notice a shift in the tone of our Scriptures readings at Mass. Our Scriptures will make more references to the "end times." This happens every November ... and appropriately so. As the last leaves turn and fall to the ground, as nature turns to the end of another life cycle, our Church asks us to reflect on the last things, namely death and the end of the world and the Second Coming of Christ. This theme will even carry into the first weeks of Advent (which begins on December 1st).

This is the perfect time of year to remember our deceased loved ones. The month began with the Feasts of All Saints and All Souls. Many of you will place a picture of them in our Sanctuary. You will see on a board the names of all whom we buried from our Church since last November. Many of you have made already or will make a trip to a cemetery.

At some point we will all face death. Realizing this does not make us morbid. Just the opposite. Christians believe death is a winter that opens up to a new and beautiful springtime. We believe there is a heaven to come, everlasting life with God and our loved ones.

Why do we believe this? One reason. Because of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Christ's resurrection shows us what is to come. This is the basis for our hope. This is the reason we believe in heaven. It is for us not just a theory or a fantasy. "Inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world," Jesus says. We believe there is more to come after death precisely because of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, our Lord and Savior.

Jesus is the only sign we need, the only assurance we need, of everlasting life in heaven. There is no need to consult mediums and fortune tellers and tarot cards. Jesus is our "blessed assurance." Look to Christ.
