GOSPEL LUKE 21:5-19

While some people were speaking about how the temple was adorned with costly stones and votive offerings, Jesus said, "All that you see here-- the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down."

Then they asked him, "Teacher, when will this happen? And what sign will there be when all these things are about to happen?" He answered, "See that you not be deceived, for many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he,' and 'The time has come.' Do not follow them! When you hear of wars and insurrections, do not be terrified; for such things must happen first, but it will not immediately be the end." Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be powerful earthquakes, famines, and plagues from place to place; and awesome sights and mighty signs will come from the sky.

"Before all this happens, however, they will seize and persecute you, they will hand you over to the synagogues and to prisons, and they will have you led before kings and governors because of my name. It will lead to your giving testimony. Remember, you are not to prepare your defense beforehand, for I myself shall give you a wisdom in speaking that all your adversaries will be powerless to resist or refute. You will even be handed over by parents, brothers, relatives, and friends, and they will put some of you to death. You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

We are grateful to our parish business manager, Theresa Segin, for her coordination of the project, as well as to those on our Maintenance Staff who helped with the move and transition. We are also grateful to those who donated furniture. Most importantly, we want to thank all of you, our parishioners, for your support and patience during this time of construction.

Many of you have asked if there will be an open house and the answer is “yes!” We have scheduled an **Open House for this coming Saturday, November 23 from 1-3pm**. Please: no household gifts! We have brought over from the “old rectory” all the items we need. Please come and take a look inside!

Speaking of the “old rectory” (we are still working on a new name for it): the dining room has already been converted into an official meeting room (it had been doubling as a dining/conference room for many years!). The rooms on the second floor are now in the process of make-overs. The upstairs will be used for offices, meetings, and counseling. This process will take some time, as money allows, but we can begin using some of the upstairs already. All of the furniture being used has been donated by parishioners and businesses.

So begins a new chapter in the life of our parish community. While all of this is very important, we must always keep in mind the most important thing that happens here happens on Sunday. The Eucharist is where we draw our strength from and our mission as individual disciples and as a parish. Buildings are important, but building up the Body of Christ is our number one priority. 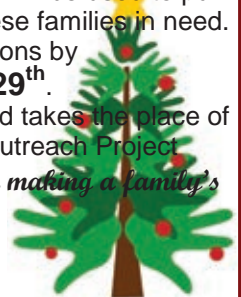
