Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." He replied to him, "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

THE MARK OF TRUE KINGSHIP

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Those who hold power and authority tend to be very interested in protecting and preserving (at all costs, sometimes) that power. Truthfully, the same goes for those who have little power and authority. If we are honest, all of us have acted at one time or another, defensively. We have all tried to save ourselves.

No less than three times in our Gospel (Luke 23:35-43), people urge Jesus to save himself. Rulers, soldiers, even a common thief, say it to Jesus: "save yourself."

They are mocking him. He is hanging on the cross. Jesus, the one who healed the sick, the one who said He had the power to forgive sins. Jesus. Son of God. Let's see you save *yourself*.

Interesting, and also sad, that so many from the highest in society to the lowest, missed the point of Jesus' preaching and teaching about the Kingdom of God. Jesus didn't come to save himself. Jesus came to save *us*.

Maybe we can't fault them for not remembering when He said: "to save your life you must lose it." It's something I don't like remembering. But here is Jesus on the cross, not thinking of Himself; but rather giving of Himself, all of Himself ... for us.

This is what makes Jesus a King. Not preserving power, but giving it away.

This last Sunday in Ordinary Time is called the **Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe**. I have a feeling the title would make Jesus blush. The night before He died, the King of the Universe said, "I call you friends." He washed the feet of His disciples. His one command was to love others the way He loved us. He did not save himself.

Why would we want to follow any other King? Why would we want to belong to any other Kingdom, but His?

Caritas Enlightenments

You Can Make a Difference – Part II

There are many things that **you**, as an Ambassador of Jesus, can do to help people with disabilities feel welcome in our parish family here at St. Joan of Arc.

1. I can be PATIENT and WAIT for the person with difficulty speaking, rather than speaking for the person. I may help by asking short questions that require short answers, a nod, or a shake of the head.
2. I can see the WHOLENESS OF SPIRIT beneath the surface of someone with a disability and overcome the tendency to turn away or ignore the person.
3. I can TREAT ADULTS with developmental disabilities AS ADULTS, not as children. I can use first names only when using the same familiarity for all persons.
4. I can get the attention of someone who is hearing-impaired by LIGHTLY TAPPING their elbow or shoulder, or by WAVING MY HAND. I can look directly at the person and speak clearly, slowly, and expressively to support the person who can read my lips.
5. I can guide a person with visual impairments by GIVING VERBAL CLUES to steps, curbs, inclines, escalators, or doors.
