When John the Baptist heard in prison of the works of the Christ, he sent his disciples to Jesus with this question, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" Jesus said to them in reply, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them. And blessed is the one who takes no offense at me."

As they were going off, Jesus began to speak to the crowds about John, "What did you go out to the desert to see? A reed swayed by the wind? Then what did you go out to see? Someone dressed in fine clothing? Those who wear fine clothing are in royal palaces. Then why did you go out? To see a prophet? Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet.

This is the one about whom it is written: *Behold, I am sending my messenger ahead of you; he will prepare your way before you.*

Amen, I say to you, among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he."

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The Magi followed a star to Bethlehem where they met the Christ Child, the Savior of the world. They did not know what they were in for. They had little idea what to expect or what they would find. They only knew that this was a journey they had to make. The Star above them beckoned and drew them and led them to a whole new understanding of God and life and love.

The light of that Star still burns and calls and invites people to follow. It might not be a bright light up in the sky, but deep within all of us there is a thirst, a need for hope and peace and joy in our lives, in our families, in our world. Deep within us there are questions about the meaning of life and death, about what our purpose is. Deep within us there is a longing to be known and loved as we are. All of these thirsts and needs, all of these questions and longings — these are the "stars" that draw us to Christ.

This Christmas we can meet Jesus in a new way, just as the Magi did. We can find in Jesus the hope and joy, the peace and love and meaning we are looking for. The Magi brought gifts to Jesus, but these are the gifts Jesus wants to give *to us* this Christmas.

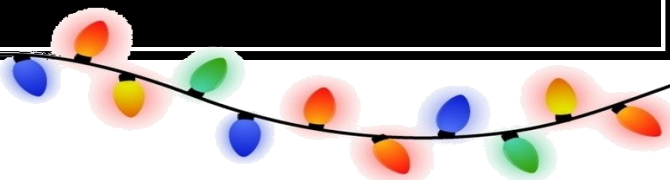


ONE IN THE SPIRIT

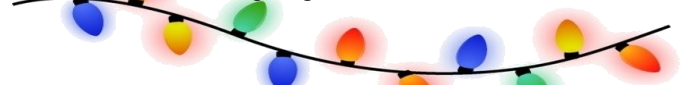
POPCORN, FRANKS & A MOVIE PRESENTS:

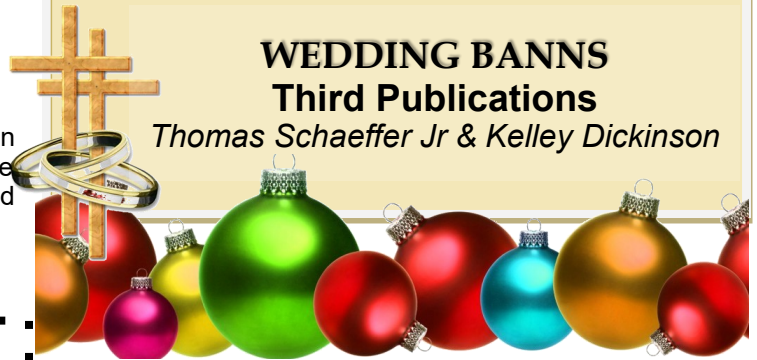
