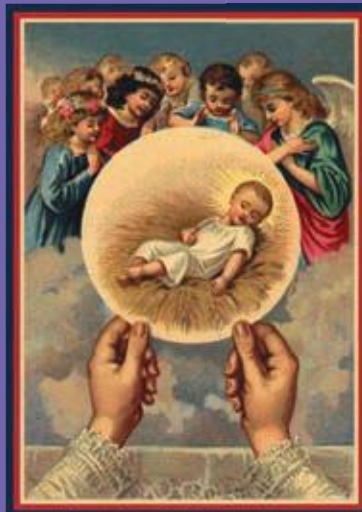

GOSPEL MATTHEW 1:18-24

This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about. When his mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found with child through the Holy Spirit. Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to divorce her quietly. Such was his intention when, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: *Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means "God is with us."* When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took his wife into his home.

Small Group Faith Sharing Questions

- 1) In the Gospel we hear the familiar phrase "do not be afraid." Where do you see fear affecting your family, your community, or the overall area in which you live?
- 2) Can you remember when in your life you experienced God's presence?
- 3) What was that experience like? How long did it last?
- 4) How would you live your life to intentionally view it as set apart for the glory of God?
- 5) Where is God calling you to greater trust?

Fourth Sunday of Advent/2019

PREPARED? ARE YOU KIDDING?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Welcome to the Fourth Week of Advent. It's not a full week. Christmas Eve is two days away. It's been a fast December because of the late Thanksgiving. In other words: *yikes! It's here!*

Because of bulletin deadlines — just to complicate things — I am writing this letter to you two weeks before it goes to print. I am not ready for Christmas as I write it, and I can guess very accurately I will still not be ready for Christmas on the Fourth Sunday of Advent. Furthermore, I'm fairly certain you're not ready for Christmas either even as you read this.

Who am I kidding? You won't have time to read this!

If, by some miracle, you do find a minute to open this bulletin and look at this letter, let me just say this: don't worry about it. I believe this is another lesson Advent wants us to learn: we will never be fully ready for Christmas ... or even for the coming of Christ.

No one is completely, 100% ready. And — here's good news — God doesn't even expect it. Someone a lot wiser than me once said, "God doesn't call the ready. God calls the willing."

Our Gospel this Sunday gives us a good example in St. Joseph (probably the most underrated person in the Nativity story). Joseph is called to be Mary's husband and the foster father of a child he knows isn't his. The Gospel gives us enough clues to know Joseph is confused. Confusion can breed fear and fear can breed isolation and isolation can breed all sorts of bad stuff.

How does Joseph deal with his confusion and thus avoid an avalanche of woe and disaster?

Joseph is willing. Willing to do what? Willing to trust in God's promise to be with him.

This Christmas, don't worry about being fully prepared. Just be willing to trust in God's promise to be with you. Just be willing, like Mary and Joseph, to trust the Holy Spirit will guide you. I think you will find an inner peace that will help make your Christmas, and your loved ones' Christmas, a joyful celebration of the birth of Christ, as well as a wonderful sharing of love.

Ready or not, on behalf of Fr. Jorge, our Sisters of St. Joseph, our Deacons and our entire Staff, I wish you the best Christmas ever.
