

A WORD (OR TWO) ON BAPTISM

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Last year we baptized a total of 224 individuals — 221 infants and children, 1 teenager and 2 adults. That's a good, healthy number. It's 31 more than we baptized in 2018. And, it is outpacing our funerals by almost a hundred (in 2019 we buried 138 persons from our parish). It's always good when a parish has more baptisms than funerals.

I have a hunch that there are more children and teens out there who have not yet been baptized. If this is the case in your family, we invite you to give us a call and see what a blessing this Sacrament is.

In Baptism we begin a new life in Christ. We are made one with Christ. In Baptism, we are freed from sin and made children of God. God promises us the gift of eternal life. God will always be with us and will always love us. In Baptism, we begin our journey as a disciple of Jesus.

After Jesus was baptized (which we hear about in today's Gospel), he began his earthly ministry of announcing the Good News of the Kingdom of God, of healing and forgiving, of reconciling the world to God and teaching us, showing us, how to live fully, joyfully and generously. Jesus began a movement of love and grace that transformed individual lives, formed a community of love and peace, and truly transformed the world.

All the baptized are part of that great movement. We welcome all who were baptized last year and all to be baptized this year. Those of us already baptized must take on the awesome responsibility of showing them what it means to live and love as a Christian, a believer in God, a disciple of Christ, filled with and energized by the Holy Spirit.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY & other helpful Winter info

Our policy has changed a bit this year, so please take a look:

RE: SJA SCHOOL AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: If Evesham Township Schools are closed, our School and Religious Ed. are also closed.

RE: WEEKDAY PROGRAMS AND MEETINGS: If School is cancelled because of weather, all scheduled events and meetings **are cancelled** (with the exception of Mass, see below:)

DAILY MASS & SUNDAY MASSES: In the extreme event when Mass is cancelled, a message will be left on our phone system and on our website, as well as Twitter and Facebook. Always use your best judgement and common sense. Trust your instinct: if you think the weather is too bad for you to go out, please stay home. It is not a mortal sin to miss Mass because of bad weather. Jesus does not want you to break a hip for Him.

WINTER ILLNESSES: If you are sick or do not feel well, you are not required to come to Mass. You are not committing a sin if you stay home because of illness. It is always more prudent to stay home.

Sign of Peace: If you have a cold or are not feeling well, please share a sign of peace during Mass with a nod of your head, a friendly smile or a wave. You do not have to shake hands. People will understand.

Remember, too: Those who are over the age of 60, and anyone with a health issue, are **not required** to fast one hour before receiving Holy Communion. **Thank you!**


