## BIBLE TIME

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Back to green. Back to Ordinary Time, as we call it in the Roman Catholic Church. Some Protestant denominations call this week and those that follow until Lent, the "Sundays after Epiphany." Many Protestant Churches also use what is called the "Common Lectionary." We use it too (A Lectionary is a book of readings). In other words, many Churches (i.e. the Lutheran, Presbyterian and some Methodists) are hearing the very same Scriptures that we hear on Sunday. That is an example of Christian Unity that many people might not be aware of.

Speaking of Christian Unity: one week out of the year, beginning always on January 18<sup>th</sup>, is always designated as "Prayer for Christian Unity Week." Let's pray for it AND work for it. We are well aware that many of our parishioners are married to Christians of other denominations. They are certainly most welcome here (as everyone is).

Next Sunday we celebrate, for the first time ever, **SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD**. It's **BYOB** (Bring Your Own Bible) **Sunday**, for short. If you don't yet have your own Bible, or if you forget, please come anyway. Sharing is fun! We will also have a special "Bible Exhibit" between Masses and more in the weekend Bulletin ... all this to encourage all of us to pick up God's Word more often and enter into it and digest it and let it become a part of our daily lives.

If you are married one week or 60 years come and embrace what God has planned for your marriage to come alive more and more each day .

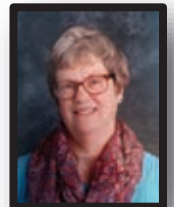

## DISCERNMENT: AN APPROACH TO GOOD CHOICES

January 27, 7:30pm Pedata Hall



Do you ever wonder if you are making the right decisions? While recovering from a serious injury in battle, St. Ignatius Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits), learned to distinguish what thoughts and desires came from God and what did not. The evening will examine what Discernment is from a spiritual perspective, how to recognize your desires and push back against movements that are not of God, and ways that you can use to make good choices both in major decisions and everyday life.

Our speaker will be Sister Pat Mensing, a Sister of St Joseph, has served as an elementary and secondary school teacher in the diocese of Harrisburg and the Archdioceses of Baltimore and Philadelphia. (If you forget or don't have a bible, don't worry about it. Sharing is fun!)

### **INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY & other helpful Winter info**

*Our policy has changed a bit this year, so please take a look:*

**RE: SJA SCHOOL AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:** If Evesham Township Schools are closed, our School and Religious Ed. are also closed.

**RE: WEEKDAY PROGRAMS AND MEETINGS:** If School is cancelled because of weather, all scheduled events and meetings **are cancelled** (with the exception of Mass, see below:)

**DAILY MASS & SUNDAY MASSES:** In the extreme event when Mass is cancelled, a message will be left on our phone system and on our website, as well as Twitter and Facebook. Always use your best judgement and common sense. Trust your instinct: if you think the weather is too bad for you to go out, please stay home. It is not a mortal sin to miss Mass because of bad weather. Jesus does not want you to break a hip for Him.

**WINTER ILLNESSES:** If you are sick or do not feel well, you are not required to come to Mass. You are not committing a sin if you stay home because of illness. It is always more prudent to stay home.

**Sign of Peace:** If you have a cold or are not feeling well, please share a sign of peace during Mass with a nod of your head, a friendly smile or a wave. You do not have to shake hands. People will understand.

**Remember, too:** Those who are over the age of 60, and anyone with a health issue, are **not required** to fast one hour before receiving Holy Communion. *Thank you!*


