GOSPEL MATTHEW 2:1-12

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage."

When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, He inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet:

And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel."

Then Herod called the magi secretly and ascertained from them the time of the star's appearance. He sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search diligently for the child. When you have found him, bring me word, that I too may go and do him homage." After their audience with the king they set out. And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.

- 1) The Magi find the newborn King they seek, not in a palace, but in a humble place in Bethlehem. Where do you find Christ's light and love in the ordinary?
- 2) From your own encounters and experiences in the world, what have you learned about the God of Creation?
- 3) St Paul's letter to the Ephesians sees the church struggling to form a unified community. In what ways do you see that today, and what can you and others do to make it better?

2020 HOUSE BLESSING

Blessing homes on the Feast of Epiphany is an old custom in many cultures. This year we invite everyone in our parish to bless your home on Sunday evening, January 5, before or after dinner.

How wonderful it will be if all the homes in our parish are blessed on the same day!
It's a great way to begin the new year.

Before the blessing: If possible, find a piece of colored chalk, **or** a piece of paper and marker, **or** an image of the Wise Men from a Christmas Card.

THE BLESSING

Everyone gathers at the front door (inside is best).

Someone says: **“On the Feast of Epiphany, the three Wise Men —Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar — followed the star to Bethlehem. There they met Jesus, the Savior of the World, laying in a manger. May Christ bless our home throughout the new year.”**

(Someone then, using the chalk, writes above the door on the molding, the year and the initials of the Magi, with a cross in between each initial, just like this:

20 + C + M + B + 20

Or, write the above on a piece of paper, cut the paper to fit on the molding above the door and tape it there,

Or, take a Christmas card with the Magi on it, and tape it somewhere on the door or nearby, writing the year on it)

Then the following prayer is said:

O Jesus, you made a home here on earth with us. We ask you to bless our home with the joy of your presence. Bless all who live or visit here with the gift of your love; and grant that we may share your love with each other and with all whose lives we touch. May we grow in grace and in the knowledge and love of you; guide, comfort, and strengthen us in peace, O Jesus Christ, both now and forever. Amen.

Everyone then prays “the Our Father” together and ends with the Sign of the Cross.

BARNABAS BAGS FOR THE HOMELESS

What are they? Fun to create, little bags that fit most budgets! Barnabas is the “son of encouragement,” so he’s a good fit. Great **ONGOING** project for a family to help homeless neighbors!

What's in them? **Be creative!** A few ideas for zip-lock sandwich bag: breakfast bar, crackers, napkin (smile face drawn on it), hand sanitizer, band-aid, hand warmer packet in winter, hand-written note with a scripture verse.

How to give them out? Have you ever passed a homeless person while crossing a bridge or walking through a city? Have you ever wanted to help but not known how? Barnabas Bags can be **kept in a car or carried easily** in a knapsack.

Will it help? They can't solve homelessness, but they give us a chance to look into the eyes of another child of God, offer a smile, a kind word & small gift. **We can make a difference for homeless neighbors ... one Barnabas Bag at a time!**

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY & other helpful Winter info

Our policy has changed a bit this year, so please take a look:

RE: SJA SCHOOL AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: If Evesham Township Schools are closed, our School and Religious Ed. are also closed.

RE: WEEKDAY PROGRAMS AND MEETINGS: If School is cancelled because of weather, all scheduled events and meetings **are cancelled** (with the exception of Mass, see below:)

DAILY MASS & SUNDAY MASSES:

In the extreme event when Mass is cancelled, a message will be left on our phone system and on our website, as well as Twitter and Facebook.

Always use your best judgement and common sense. Trust your instinct: if you think the weather is too bad for you to go out, please stay home. It is not a mortal sin to miss Mass because of bad weather. Jesus does not want you to break a hip for Him.

WINTER ILLNESSES

If you are sick or do not feel well, you are not required to come to Mass. You are not committing a sin if you stay home because of illness. It is always more prudent to stay home.

Sign of Peace: If you have a cold or are not feeling well, please share a sign of peace during Mass with a nod of your head, a friendly smile or a wave. You do not have to shake hands. People will understand.

Remember, too: Those who are 62 years of age or older, and anyone with a health issue, are **not required** to fast one hour before receiving Holy Communion.
