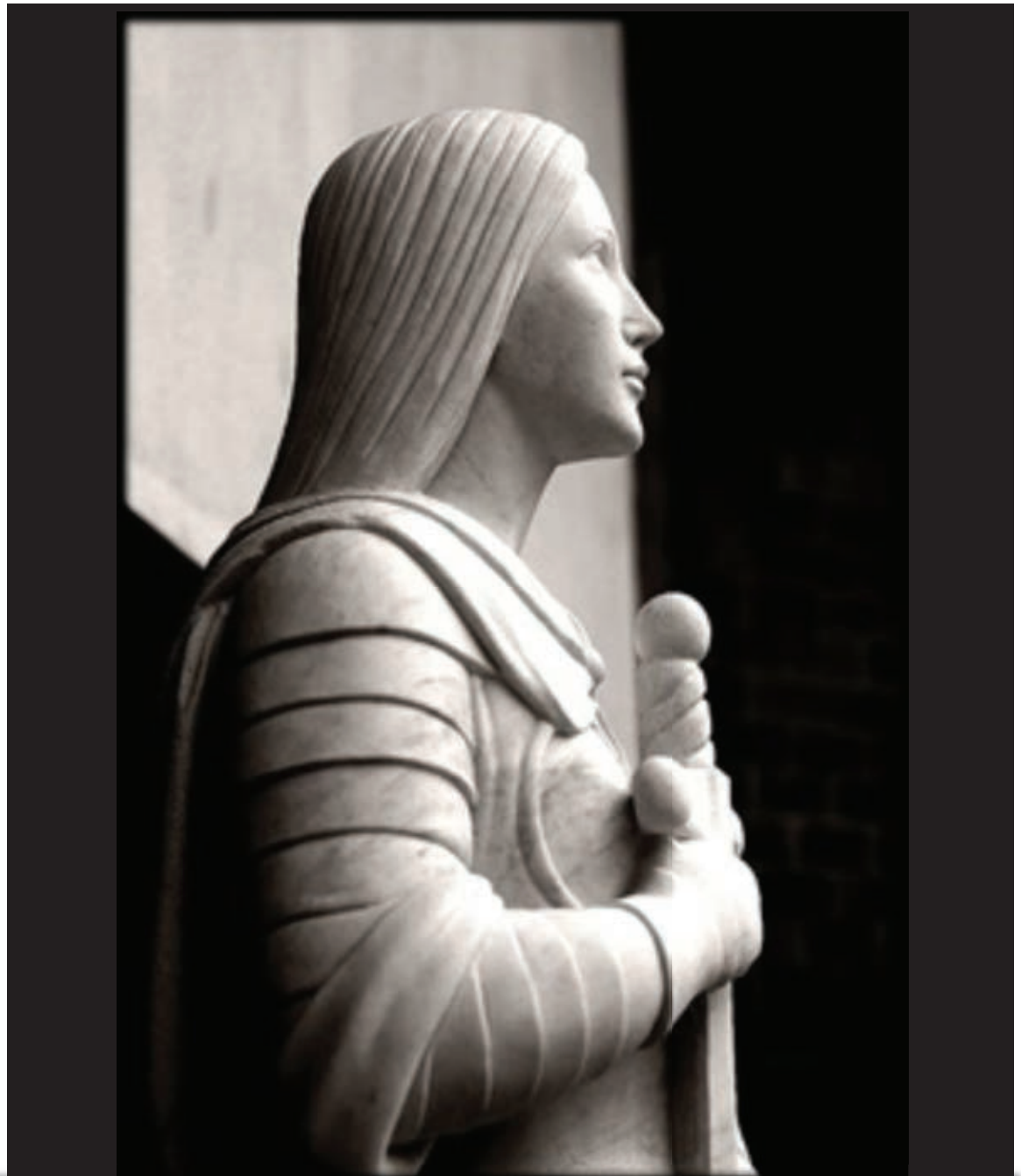

GOSPEL MATTHEW 5:13-16

Jesus said to his disciples:

“You are the salt of the earth. But if salt loses its taste, with what can it be seasoned? It is no longer good for anything but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot. You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket; it is set on a lampstand, where it gives light to all in the house. Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father.”

SMALL GROUP FAITH SHARING QUESTIONS

- 1) With your time, or treasure or talent, is your heart open to giving from your need, and not from your excess? What do you experience when you give from your need?
- 2) St. Paul tells us that we do not have to be eloquent in word, but just trust that God has all that we need to talk with others about His love and compassion for us. Do you find yourself trusting in God to bring His words of life to others? Do you fear talking to others about His love? Will you trust?
- 3) Jesus gives us this Gospel message immediately following the beatitudes, Salt and Light. Are you open with others about your faith and love for Jesus Christ? How do you do that in a way that is not offensive?

Dear Parishioners and Friends

We are all familiar with the Statue of Liberty and its rich symbols.

Every time I see that statue, I recall the words of Jesus “to be a light in the world.” Like the Statue’s torch that lights the way to freedom, we are called to be a shining example of virtue and integrity.


