1st Sunday of Lent/2020 **RETHINK LENT**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

When have you had to rethink your position on a subject? Rethinking, of course, more times than not, involves a changing of one's mind. Rethinking might even change a heart.

If we think about it (or think about it again), for his original disciples following Jesus involved quite a bit of rethinking. They had to rethink their understanding of where the Messiah would come from and what kind of Messiah he would be. They had to rethink what it meant to be a religious person. While Jesus didn't do away with the Law, he challenged his followers to rethink their relationship with the Law and with God. And to really add fuel to the fire of conversion, Jesus challenged his friends to rethink their relationship to Gentiles, foreigners, women and children, the unclean (aka lepers) and the poor.

Maybe this year we can rethink Lent. Oh, continue to do the fasting, continue doing works of charity and kindness, continue giving up and making sacrifices, continue praying and reading Scripture and going to Mass ... but rethink the purpose of all this. Why are you doing this? How will this remake you in the image of Christ? In what ways will of this make an impact on your life *after* the 40 days are over, on Easter Sunday and beyond.


