GOSPEL JOHN 11:3-7, 17, 20-27, 33b-45

The sisters of Lazarus sent word to Jesus, saying, "Master, the one you love is ill." When Jesus heard this he said, "This illness is not to end in death, but is for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it." Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. So when he heard that he was ill, he remained for two days in the place where he was. Then after this he said to his disciples, "Let us go back to Judea."

When Jesus arrived, he found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days. When Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went to meet him; but Mary sat at home. Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. But even now I know that whatever you ask of God, God will give you." Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise." Martha said, "I know he will rise, in the resurrection on the last day." Jesus told her, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" She said to him, "Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world."

He became perturbed and deeply troubled, and said, "Where have you laid him?" They said to him, "Sir, come and see." And Jesus wept. So the Jews said, "See how he loved him." But some of them said, "Could not the one who opened the eyes of the blind man have done something so that this man would not have died?"

So Jesus, perturbed again, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay across it. Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the dead man's sister, said to him, "Lord, by now there will be a stench; he has been dead for four days." Jesus said to her, "Did I not tell you that if you believe you will see the glory of God?" So they took away the stone. And Jesus raised his eyes and said, "Father, I thank you for hearing me. I know that you always hear me; but because of the crowd here I have said this, that they may believe that you sent me." And when he had said this, He cried out in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" The dead man came out, tied hand and foot with burial bands, and his face was wrapped in a cloth. So Jesus said to them, "Untie him and let him go." Now many of the Jews who had come to Mary and seen what he had done began to believe in him.

WE HAVE A SAVIOR

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I'm sure we are all learning many lessons during "the days of our confinement," as I'm calling them. One lesson that has hit me square in the eyes is how vulnerable we all are. To be vulnerable is to be in need. We need to be rescued from this virus, this invader, this pestilence. And we need each other. We will get through this, but it will be together, helping each other.

We also need God. That's a fundamental belief in our religion, our faith. Without God we are nothing. God is our Savior.

This Sunday we hear the great story of the raising of Lazarus. "Lazarus, come out," Jesus says, commanding him to come out of the tomb. We've been shut in these past two weeks. Our God knows the way out. We see it time and time again in the Bible. God knows the way out ... the way out of the desert, the way out of the wilderness, the way out of the tomb, the way out of every dark place!

We are vulnerable, yes, but we are not alone. We have each other ... and we have more. We have a Savior, Jesus Christ, who is our Good Shepherd, who knows our name, who knows our deepest thirsts and longings, who knows the way out of darkness and death into the light and new life.

Let the message and presence of Jesus revive your spirit today and throughout the week. Let the message of Jesus, the presence of Jesus, breathe peace and hope into your being.

re-LENT in 2020 “REVIVE”

REVIVE. to bring back to life. to energize. to give new strength. Once again we see how the Bible is the Living Word of God. This week’s Gospel, the story of the raising of Lazarus, is so appropriate to our times. Like Martha, we may wonder “where Jesus is” during this pandemic. “If you had been here,” Martha says ... kind of scolding Jesus. But notice how the encounter with Jesus moves Martha from sadness and grief to trust and a deeper faith. This is important. Martha’s attitude, her disposition, does not stay fixed. Her relationship with Jesus moves. You may have noticed that there was a similar movement in the woman by the well (two weeks ago) and also the blind man (last week).

As the days and weeks of confinement and quarantine continue, let’s pray that our faith moves and grows as well. If your faith has been dormant or wavering, this is a good time to encounter Jesus in a new way. Ask him: “revive my faith!” At the end of this pandemic, we can be truly changed people — healed in many ways, not just physically. Jesus can take us to a new place. He can take us out of whatever darkness has a hold on us. Like Lazarus, we can be raised and moved to a new place, a place of greater trust and hope, a place of greater love and life.

PRAYER FOR SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

“My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.

Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You are already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen.”

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION MINISTRY

Registration Beginning in April

Our mission is to help parents share the Catholic faith with their children through several methods of learning. We hope to bring these young people to a deeper relationship with God from the teachings and love of Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.

Methods of learning:

- Traditional classroom: On Monday or Tuesday afternoons for Grades 1-5 and Monday or Tuesday evenings for Grades 6,7, and 8. This program runs from September until May.
 - Home Study - Grades 3,4,5 and 6. This is for parents who cannot bring their child to the Monday or Tuesday classroom settings. The parent would teach the child at home one lesson per week. We also ask that your child attend three activities throughout the school year.
 - Family Catechesis: - This program is offered to 1st and 2nd grade parents only. As a parent you will teach your child at home for three weeks with curriculum provided and then attend a class once a month in the evening with your child to reinforce what was taught at home. Both parent and child must attend this once a month class. Dates for once a month classes will be announced in July.
 - Special Disciples - This is a classroom setting for those with special needs. Our catechists are certified to teach children with special needs and we have a one on one approach with the children. This program runs every other Sunday during the 9am Mass from October until April. Please register for traditional classes as soon as possible as our Monday classes fill quickly.
- Tuition** : 1 child-\$100, 2 children-\$125 3+ children -\$150
