## GOSPEL LUKE 24:13-35

That very day, the first day of the week, two of Jesus' disciples were going to a village seven miles from Jerusalem called Emmaus, and they were conversing about all the things that had occurred. And it happened that while they were conversing and debating, Jesus himself drew near and walked with them, but their eyes were prevented from recognizing him. He asked them, "What are you discussing as you walk along?" They stopped, looking downcast. One of them, named Cleopas, said to him in reply, "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know of the things that have taken place there in these days?" And he replied to them, "What sort of things?" They said to him, "The things that happened to Jesus the Nazarene, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, how our chief priests and rulers both handed him over to a sentence of death and crucified him. But we were hoping that he would be the one to redeem Israel; and besides all this, it is now the third day since this took place. Some women from our group, however, have astounded us: they were at the tomb early in the morning and did not find his body; they came back and reported that they had indeed seen a vision of angels who announced that he was alive. Then some of those with us went to the tomb and found things just as the women had described, but him they did not see." And he said to them, "Oh, how foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them what referred to him in all the Scriptures. As they approached the village to which they were going, he gave the impression that he was going on farther. But they urged him, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening and the day is almost over." So he went in to stay with them. And it happened that, while he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight. Then they said to each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?" So they set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them who were saying, "The Lord has truly been raised and has appeared to Simon!" Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of bread.

## ON A SUNDAY

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Are you having trouble keeping track of days? One parishioner told me in an email that there are no more weekends. Every day feels the same. We forget what day of the week it is. We forget the date.

But Sunday is still important!

Today's Gospel passage from St. Luke begins this way: "That very day, the first day of the week!" That means: SUNDAY. This is the very last chapter in St. Luke. He tells us that on that "very day," two disciples of Jesus leave Jerusalem and take a seven mile walk. Something amazing happens during that walk. As they talk to each other about "all that had happened," regarding the crucifixion of their teacher, Jesus of Nazareth, that same Christ, now risen from the dead, appears to them and walks with them, although they do not as of yet recognize him. Christ does more than walk — He converses with them! He teaches them about the Scriptures. And then, later, when the two disciples invite this man to sit at table with them, their eyes are opened when He breaks bread and shares it with them. Christ Jesus is risen and truly with them!

All of this on a Sunday!!!

If possible, I would strongly urge all of us, even during our "days of confinement," to find a way to make Sunday special. Get in the habit (or back in the habit) of setting aside time on Sunday for God and family and the faith community. This is the way it was for 2000 years of Christianity. Maybe this quarantine can help remind us of the value of a sabbath ... a day of "rest."

Obviously our world is different today and when things go back to "normal," there will be many who will have to work on Sunday. That's okay. But even working there can be a way to highlight Sunday, to honor Sunday as a day to walk with Jesus, to let Jesus teach us through the Scriptures and feed us with His presence in the Eucharist.

A Sunday with God should include quiet time for prayer and Scripture reading. A Sunday with family could include a family meal. A Sunday with the faith community should include Mass when we come to walk and be taught and fed by Jesus **together**.

Through the COVID 19 quarantine, we are (re)learning how valuable these things are, how necessary they are for the health of our body, mind, soul and community. Let's not forget this important lesson when store doors and soccer fields and theaters are opened again.

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION MINISTRY Registration Postponed Until Further Notice

Our mission is to help parents share the Catholic faith with their children through several methods of learning. We hope to bring these young people to a deeper relationship with God from the teachings and love of Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.

Methods of learning:

- **Traditional classroom:** On Monday or Tuesday afternoons for Grades 1-5 and Monday or Tuesday evenings for Grades 6,7, and 8. This program runs from September until May.
  - **Home Study - Grades 3,4,5 and 6.** This is for parents who cannot bring their child to the Monday or Tuesday classroom settings. The parent would teach the child at home one lesson per week. We also ask that your child attend three activities throughout the school year.
  - **Family Catechesis:** - This program is offered to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade parents only. As a parent you will teach your child at home for three weeks with curriculum provided and then attend a class once a month in the evening with your child to reinforce what was taught at home. Both parent and child must attend this once a month class. Dates for once a month classes will be announced in July.
  - **Special Disciples** - This is a classroom setting for those with special needs. Our catechists are certified to teach children with special needs and we have a one on one approach with the children. This program runs every other Sunday during the 9am Mass from October until April.  
Please register for traditional classes as soon as possible as our Monday classes fill quickly.
- Tuition :** 1 child-\$100, 2 children-\$125 3+ children-\$150
