GOSPEL JOHN 10:1-10

Jesus said:

“Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber. But whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him, and the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice. But they will not follow a stranger; they will run away from him, because they do not recognize the voice of strangers.” Although Jesus used this figure of speech, the Pharisees did not realize what he was trying to tell them.

So Jesus said again, “Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. A thief comes only to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly.”

THE SHEPHERD FOR US TODAY

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I'm sure I've mentioned this before, either in a bulletin letter, a talk or a homily, but I think it bears repeating (plus, I can't remember what I've said a week ago so I'm counting on many of you being in the same boat): the earliest artwork depicting Jesus was not of him on a cross. Some of the earliest images of Jesus to be found, drawn on tombs in the catacombs, is of Jesus as the Good Shepherd (see bulletin cover).

It is easy to see why this would be so. When you are going through difficult times, as the early Christians certainly did, persecution being one of the travails they faced, there is no better image of Jesus to console you than the Good Shepherd. Jesus, the one who knows us by name, who protects us, who will go in search of us when we are lost or in danger, who comforts us, who will not abandon us. As we continue our “days of confinement,” let's call upon the Good Shepherd to guide and protect us. May we remain as faithful to Christ during this crisis as the first generation of Christians remained faithful during the time of persecution.

In our Gospel today Jesus refers to himself not only as the shepherd but also as the gate through which the sheep enter. Each morning, let us resolve and ask God's grace to enter the day through Christ; may we follow Christ through every doorway we walk and may we bring the peace and joy of Christ with us. And, too, on the day we can go out again, may we go with Christ and take Christ with us and share Christ with all whom we meet.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION MINISTRY Registration Open

by Mail Only

Our mission is to help parents share the Catholic faith with their children through several methods of learning. We hope to bring these young people to a deeper relationship with God from the teachings and love of Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.

Methods of learning:

- **Traditional classroom:** On Monday or Tuesday afternoons for Grades 1-5 and Monday or Tuesday evenings for Grades 6,7, and 8. This program runs from September until May.
- **Home Study - Grades 3,4,5 and 6.** This is for parents who cannot bring their child to the Monday or Tuesday classroom settings. The parent would teach the child at home one lesson per week. We also ask that your child attend three activities throughout the school year.
- **Family Catechesis:** - This program is offered to 1st and 2nd grade parents only. As a parent you will teach your child at home for three weeks with curriculum provided and then attend a class once a month in the evening with your child to reinforce what was taught at home. Both parent and child must attend this once a month class. Dates for once a month classes will be announced in July.

- **Special Disciples** - This is a classroom setting for those with special needs. Our catechists are certified to teach children with special needs and we have a one on one approach with the children. This program runs every other Sunday during the 9am Mass from October until April.
