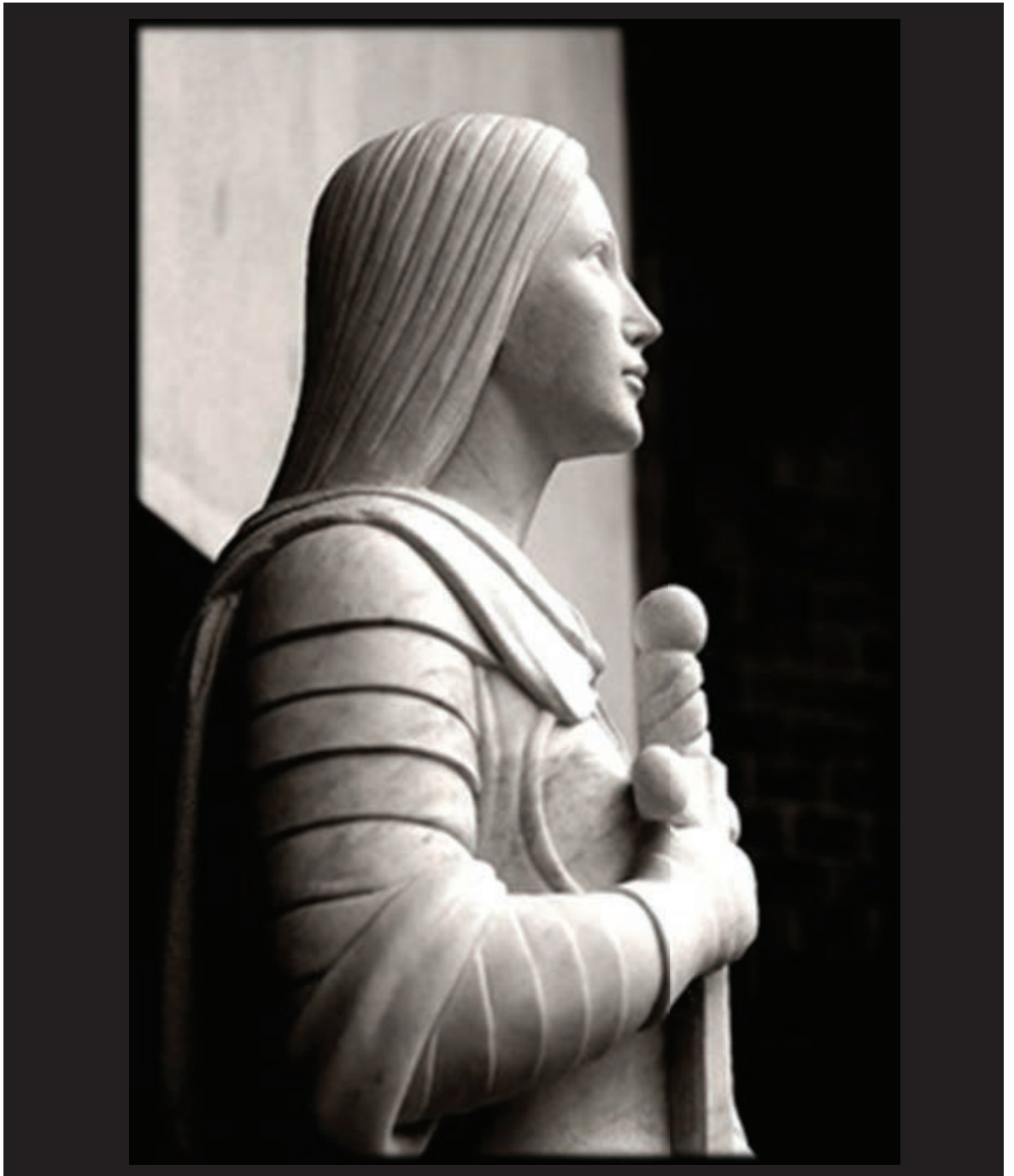

GOSPEL MATTHEW 13:1-9

On that day, Jesus went out of the house and sat down by the sea. Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat down, and the whole crowd stood along the shore. And he spoke to them at length in parables, saying:

“A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seed fell on the path, and birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, where it had little soil. It sprang up at once because the soil was not deep, and when the sun rose it was scorched, and it withered for lack of roots. Some seed fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked it. But some seed fell on rich soil and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold. Whoever has ears ought to hear.”

QUESTIONS TO SHARE

- 1) Looking back through your life's lens into your past, have you experienced environments that have been like rocky soil, thorny ground and rich soil? Explain them to a friend.
- 2) In what ways today do you make room for God's word to form your life?
- 3) How do you personally understand and feel about the last statement of Jesus to His disciples “But the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirty-fold.” Why do you think Jesus speaks to them in parables?
- 4) In what other ways can you cultivate rich soil in your life - now - so that you may grow in faith and be closer to God?

SHORT STORY, BIG POINT

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Parables. Frederick Buechner says “parables are short stories with a big point.” And that big point is usually about the Kingdom of God. In fact, Jesus will begin many of his parables with “The Kingdom of Heaven (or God) is like ...”

Some things to note and ponder regarding Jesus' parables:

When Jesus told stories he used examples from daily living that would be very familiar to his listeners. Ask yourself: if Jesus were here and now, what images would he use in daily life today to make the same big point about the Kingdom of God.

The parables usually contained a surprise — something unexpected, that was probably even quite humorous to his original listeners. Try to find the surprise, the “twist.” Often, the “twist” helps to make Jesus' point.

In many of the parables, there is something large, big, abundant, overflowing, perhaps even what we might call extravagant. Try to listen for this detail in the stories. Again, what would this say about the Kingdom of God.

Read chapter thirteen in the Gospel of Matthew. Ask yourself: what do they say TO ME about the Kingdom of God?

As one who loves to read books, and primarily books of fiction, I love the fact that Jesus loved to tell stories. Stories open us up to a new world. Isn't this what Jesus wants to do in every one of his “short stories with a big point”? Doesn't He want to open us up, open our eyes, our hearts, our arms, to the reality of God's presence?

Tell us a story, Jesus, about the Kingdom of Heaven. Tell us a story that will make us new!

Youth Faith Formation

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION MINISTRY

Registration Open by Mail Only

Our mission is to help parents share the Catholic faith with their children through several methods of learning. We hope to bring these young people to a deeper relationship with God from the teachings and love of Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.

Methods of learning:

- Traditional classroom: On Monday or Tuesday afternoons for Grades 1-5 and Monday or Tuesday evenings for Grades 6,7, and 8. This program runs from September until May.
- Home Study - Grades 3,4,5 and 6. This is for parents who cannot bring their child to the Monday or Tuesday classroom settings. The parent would teach the child at home one lesson per week. We also ask that your child attend three activities throughout the school year.
- Family Catechesis: - This program is offered to 1st and 2nd grade parents only. As a parent you will teach your child at home for three weeks with curriculum provided and then attend a class once a month in the evening with your child to reinforce what was taught at home. Both parent and child must attend this once a month class. Dates for once a month classes will be announced in July.
- Special Disciples - This is a classroom setting for those with special needs. Our catechists are certified to teach children with special needs and we have a one on one approach with the children. This program runs every other Sunday during the 9am Mass from October until April.

Please register for traditional classes as soon as possible as our Monday classes fill quickly.
