## Self Interest & Voting

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

"Do nothing out of selfishness," St. Paul writes to the Philippians and to us. This statement could easily be put in that category of "easier said than done." Putting my interests above others, doing what is good for me, seeking my own advantage seems to come naturally and often. That selfish drive to put me over you is part of what we call "original sin." It's part of the human condition.

Fortunately, there is something called Grace. Grace is the free gift of God with us, the indwelling of God's Spirit, the love of Jesus Christ poured into us. One with Christ, acquiring the attitude of Christ who humbled himself, we can empty ourselves and live, as St. Paul says, "regarding others as more important than ourselves," looking out not simply for our own interests but the interests of others.

Whose interests did Jesus heed? The obvious answer is: "the poor."

Now, "the poor" isn't just people without money. If we look at the whole of Jesus' ministry and teaching, the poor are the powerless, the voiceless, the forgotten, the stranger, the vulnerable, the abused and oppressed, the person(s) most difficult to love, the person(s) society would rather do without.

It is the interest of these people that I should always put before my own, as St. Paul instructs, inside and outside of the church building, inside and outside of the home and neighborhood, inside and outside of the workplace, inside and outside of the voting booth.

Even as I write these words, I know I fail at this so many times. I live very selfishly. May God's grace give me the strength and the courage to live and love as Christ, to empty myself of the fear and ego that keep me from this calling.

## Principal's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

Peace! Hope you and yours are well. It was great celebrating our 9:00 AM opening liturgy with those who were able to attend in person and those who joined us online on Friday, September 18. We so appreciate your presence and prayerful support.

Our opening has been like no other. Based on our enrollment numbers we had to choose a Hybrid schedule, as it was unsafe to bring all of the students in at the same time. Group A students come in person on Monday/Tuesday and Group B students come in on Wednesday/Thursday. On Fridays all students are remote, and we celebrate our Catholic Identity beginning with 9:00 AM liturgy. Teachers then meet with their full class virtually followed by time with students who are entirely remote this semester.

Mask wearing, temperature taking, social distancing and lots of hand washing are required as part of our daily routine. We have social interaction time within assigned groups and we provide mask breaks outside throughout the day. In between all of the safety protocols we are focused on the necessary academic skills.

The children have been absolutely wonderful! They are adjusting to this new way of learning and are doing the best they can. Our "hope" is that this new normal is short lived, and we will eventually get back to some of our more familiar and comfortable ways.

Our school theme this year is **LIVE IN HOPE**. We are trying to surround our children with peaceful, positive, hopeful messages as each day unfolds. Our "hope" in Jesus continues to strengthen us daily.

We are waiting for a delivery of Chromebooks for our students starting with our eighth graders and working our way down the grades. CARES money, parish subsidy and generous donations are helping to make this possible.

Thanks so much to all of you who have made donations throughout these pandemic months to assist with tuition and school expenses. Our school budget has certainly been affected by losing three major fundraisers in May (Golf Classic, Handbag Bingo and Race for Education ~ approximately \$70,000) along with Carnival revenue. While many of our parents are able to be faithful to tuition payments, others have had difficulty meeting this responsibility.

Unfortunately we will not be able to hold our Annual Christmas Bazaar this November. That fundraiser was always a good start of the year and a great community event. Please know we will continue to be ever so grateful for your goodness to us. Be assured of a remembrance in our daily prayers.

Our first reading in our opening liturgy was from Jeremiah. As we end the month of September and begin October, may his words take root in our hearts:

*"I know well the plans I have for you. I will give you a future full of HOPE"*

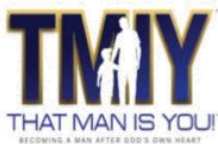

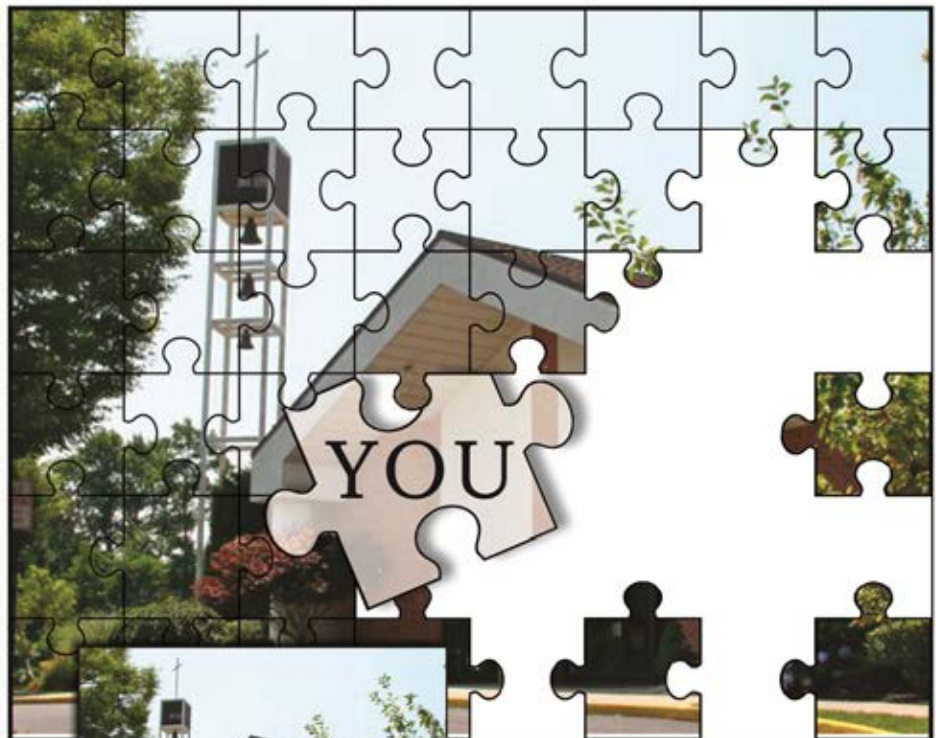
