## GOSPEL MATTHEW 22:1-14

Jesus again in reply spoke to the chief priests and elders of the people in parables, saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son. He dispatched his servants to summon the invited guests to the feast, but they refused to come. A second time he sent other servants, saying, 'Tell those invited: "Behold, I have prepared my banquet, my calves and fattened cattle are killed, and everything is ready; come to the feast.'"

Some ignored the invitation and went away, one to his farm, another to his business. The rest laid hold of his servants, mistreated them, and killed them. The king was enraged and sent his troops, destroyed those murderers, and burned their city. Then he said to his servants, 'The feast is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy to come. Go out, therefore, into the main roads and invite to the feast whomever you find.' The servants went out into the streets and gathered all they found, bad and good alike, and the hall was filled with guests. But when the king came in to meet the guests, he saw a man there not dressed in a wedding garment.

The king said to him, 'My friend, how is it that you came in here without a wedding garment?'

But he was reduced to silence. Then the king said to his attendants, 'Bind his hands and feet, and cast him into the darkness outside, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth.'

Many are invited, but few are chosen."

## Fill 'Er Up

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

"Everything is ready; come to the feast!"

We hear these words in a parable Jesus tells in the 22<sup>nd</sup> chapter of Matthew's Gospel (22:1-14). The King, who is throwing a wedding feast for his son, wants the banquet hall filled.

**Filled!** Now there's a word we don't hear much today during this pandemic. Nothing is filled. Churches, restaurants, stadiums, theaters, if it is a place where people gather, it is definitely not filled. 25% of capacity or 150 individuals, whichever is less.

What about heaven? Filled or only 25% capacity?

We learn from this parable that God is not stingy with His invitations. We learn too that God invites all to the feast, the good and the bad. Some, we hear, flat out turn down the invitation. Some want to kill the messenger. Many accept the invitation, but some, even when they get to the party do not fully participate.

What keeps me from fully responding to Christ's invitation to follow Him and to love as He loves? What keeps me from fully participating in the love and joy that God wants to share in His presence here and later in the fulfillment of the Kingdom? How effective am I in sharing God's invitation? Is there some way in the way I follow Christ that might lead others to choose not to follow? Good questions. Tough questions.

This is what parables do: they raise good, tough questions. What questions does this parable raise for you? How does this parable speak to you as a disciple of Christ? What questions does this parable raise for our parish community as well as the Universal Church?

Please know that Fr. Jorge and I, as well as Fr. Richard, our Deacons and Sisters, continue to pray for you and your families. May God continue to bless and protect you.

For 2021 Spring Installation

- 6"x 9" paver with ALL CAPITAL LETTERING, 3 lines of 16 characters per line, including spacing and punctuation is \$100. Only 6 X 9 pavers are remaining.
- Cross on paver can be purchased for an additional \$5. It will only be placed on the top of the paver and centered.

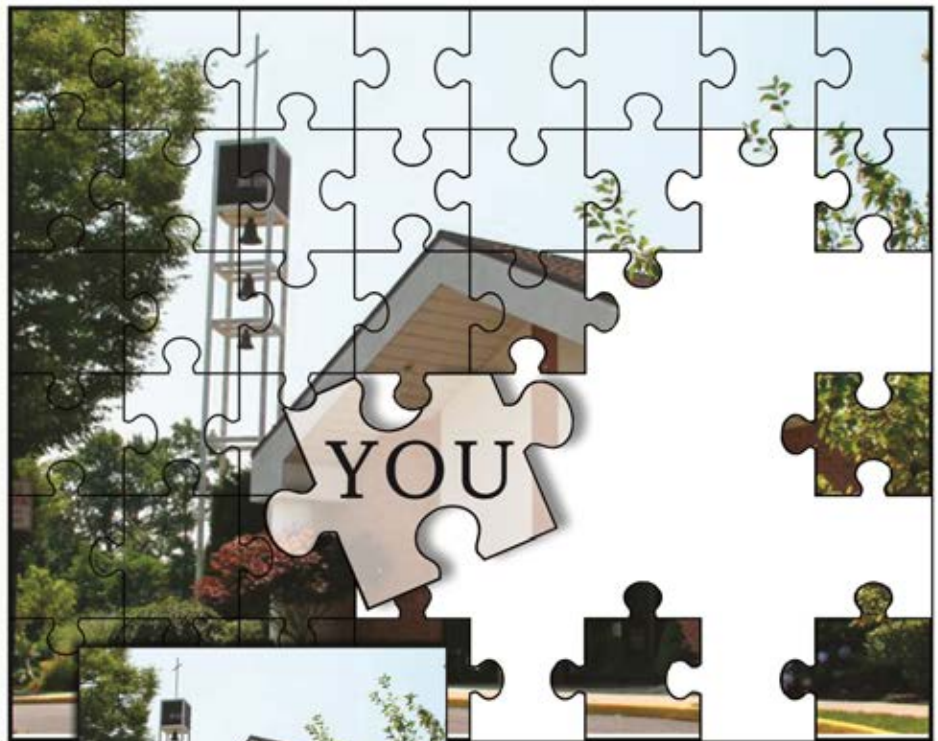
