GOSPEL MATTHEW 21:33-43

Jesus said to the chief priests and the elders of the people: "Hear another parable. There was a landowner who planted a vineyard, put a hedge around it, dug a wine press in it, and built a tower. Then he leased it to tenants and went on a journey. When vintage time drew near, he sent his servants to the tenants to obtain his produce. But the tenants seized the servants and one they beat, another they killed, and a third they stoned. Again he sent other servants, more numerous than the first ones, but they treated them in the same way. Finally, he sent his son to them, thinking, 'They will respect my son.' But when the tenants saw the son, they said to one another, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and acquire his inheritance.' They seized him, threw him out of the vineyard, and killed him. What will the owner of the vineyard do to those tenants when he comes?" They answered him, "He will put those wretched men to a wretched death and lease his vineyard to other tenants who will give him the produce at the proper times."

Jesus said to them, "Did you never read in the Scriptures:

The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; by the Lord has this been done, and it is wonderful in our eyes? Therefore, I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people that will produce its fruit."

Welcome Knights Hall

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The three car garage in the "old rectory" has been fully renovated and I am now happy to announce the opening of a new meeting room here on our parish grounds called **Knights Hall**. The new hall, larger than the Arc Room and smaller than Pedata Hall, will normally accommodate gatherings of 25 to 40 persons, depending on whether or not tables are used. Because of COVID-19 restrictions, we are currently allowing no more than 10 persons to occupy the space.

We have named the new room "**Knights Hall**" for two reasons: first, in honor of our parish patron, **St. Joan of Arc**, a courageous, faith-filled knight herself who, as a servant of the Lord, inspired many a knight to follow her; and, second, in humble gratitude for the very generous donation from our local **Knights of Columbus Fr. John P.**

Wessel Council 6530 which provided the greater part of the project's funding. Council 6530 has long been present to the parish community, inviting and involving our parishioners to participate in their many activities. **On behalf of the entire parish, thank you, Council 6530!**



Because of its generous gift to the parish, we are happy to give Council 6530 use of the hall for Council meetings, as well as much needed storage space. To prevent confusion, however, it is important for everyone to

understand that Knights Hall belongs to the Church of St. Joan of Arc and is meant to be used by various parish groups and committees throughout the week.

With the opening of Knights Hall, as well as two new Conference Rooms in the "old rectory," it is our hope to provide more space for our parishioners to gather for ministry and support meetings as well as faith sharing, Bible studies, etc. It will also free up Pedata Hall to be used by other larger groups.

I wish we could hold an open house so that everyone could come inside and take a peek at all of the offices and meeting rooms. One day soon, hopefully, we will be able to do so safely.

Please know how grateful I am to the Knights and to all our parish ministries for their continued patience and cooperation during this pandemic. Likewise, it is because of the continued generosity of our parishioners that even during this pandemic our parish has been able to continue praising God and serving God's people. From the bottom of my heart, thank you!

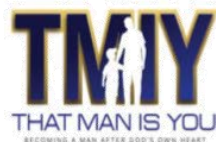
