Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This has been a tough year to grieve. Who ever heard of social distancing at a funeral? How do you properly grieve wearing a mask standing six feet apart, no hugging, no physical contact? Back in the spring during the quarantine, many people said farewell to loved ones without a funeral Mass or Service, simply graveside prayers with no more than ten family members and friends. While justified and for good reason, it was still a difficult year to grieve. As a parish our hearts go out to all who lost loved ones this year. We share in your sadness and want you to know that you are not alone. All during the month of November we will take time to remember and pray for our recently departed.

Appropriately, the Church begins this Season of Remembrance with the Feast of All Saints (Nov. 1) and the Commemoration of All Souls (Nov. 2). On these two days the Church around the world pauses to remember, first, our Faith Heroes, the women and men who followed Christ before us, who passed on our Christian belief, who showed us by the example of their lives how to love and care for one another as Christ taught us; and then, second, we remember and pray for all the faithful departed, including our parents and grandparents, daughters and sons, brothers and sisters, relatives and friends, all our dearly beloved. We pray for the souls in purgatory, that is, those on their journey home to the heart of God. We remember the people in cemeteries everywhere, people of ages past, perhaps forgotten to us but never to God.

It is the mercy of God that has the final word, the word of life and love. God's love is stronger than death! We believe this because of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, our Savior who on the cross conquered sin and death, all that separates and divides. In Christ we are united with our loved ones and with God.

Let us pray for our deceased: “Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. May all the souls of the faithful, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.”

Please follow each daily intention with one Our Father, one Hail Mary, and one Glory Be.

Day One: Monday, October 26: As we prepare for the national & local elections, in the midst of a global pandemic, may our political engagement be guided by our Catholic faith.

Day Two: Tuesday, October 27: In this month of the Holy Rosary, may Our Blessed Mother guide us in confronting racial inequalities and restoring peace in our communities.

Day Three: Wednesday, October 28: May all Americans recall the necessity of dialogue, civility, and humility in this election season.

Day Four: Thursday, October 29: May all people understand the moral and ethical dimensions of political decisions and decide accordingly.

Day Five: Friday, October 30: May voters & elected leaders uphold the dignity of every human life in their political engagement.

Day Six: Saturday, October 31: May we as Catholics recall all aspects of Catholic social teaching as they consider their votes.

Day Seven: Sunday, November 1: May there be a transformation of politics to focus on the dignity of the human person and the common good.

Day Eight: Monday, November 2: May we keep in mind the gift of religious freedom and our duty to defend and exercise it as faithful citizens.

Day Nine: Tuesday, November 3: As we vote may we understand & embrace the principles of our faith that guide our political engagement.

Closing: Wednesday, November 4: May the leaders elected this week be guided by the Holy Spirit as they fulfill their positions.

RESPECT LIFE Update

On Oct 5, the NJ Bishops released a statement rejecting the recent announcement of NJ to enact a "Reproductive Freedom" bill. This legislation would make abortion legal in all 9 months of pregnancy, remove any conscience protection laws for the doctors and nurses involved and make it mandatory for all NJ insurance companies to cover abortions. The Bishops in their statement said " we urge all Catholics and people of good will to reject this proposed legislative initiative in our State and to contact your State legislators to vigorously express opposition to its passage".

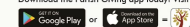
