TO THE END OF (ORDINARY) TIME



Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I think it is safe to say no one will be sad to see this year end. A year that started out with so much excitement ... just the sound of 2020, perfect vision, sounded so hopeful. Well, without losing the hope, we will all be happy to set our sights on 2021!

Our Gospel this time of year speak of the end of things, the end of time and the second coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ. In yet another parable from Matthew's Gospel, Jesus will challenge us to look carefully at how we use the gifts God gives us as we await the day of Christ's return. The parable isn't meant to frighten us or to cause us undue anxiety or dismay but to rally us and encourage us. Even in the midst of pandemic turmoil, we know God has given us much to be thankful for. Let's use wisely and well the time and the gifts we have.

Things to watch out for: next Sunday will mark the Feast of Christ the King and the last Sunday in Ordinary Time (there has been nothing "ordinary" about this year!). This means the following Sunday, though still in November, is the First Sunday of Advent — a new season, a new liturgical year and the beginning of our preparation for Christmas. Somewhere near the end of the month I hope to offer a short YouTube lesson on the meaning of Advent.

We do not know yet exactly how we will celebrate Christmas. Obviously, we had all hoped we would be "back to normal" by this time, but it does not look like that will be the case. Our Liturgy Planning Team and staff have been meeting and discussing this since mid-October. We are looking at many options, always with the realization that everything could change at the last minute. As soon as decisions are made, we will alert the entire parish. As always, the goal is to help us keep ourselves and each other as safe as possible while providing much needed opportunities for people to pray, worship and celebrate the Eucharist especially during the holy Seasons of Advent and Christmas.

Recently we've done extensive work both outside and inside here on our campus. Work is nearing completion on hopefully solving some drainage issues that have been with us for some time. Also, as you may know, we've had some ongoing issues with the restrooms in the main vestibule of the church. Buildings, like people, as they get older, encounter plumbing problems. As I write this letter, these issues are also being addressed and hopefully resolved.

Every end brings a new beginning. Remember: when we HOPE we are Holding Onto the Promise Everyday ... the promise of God's presence and love in our lives. That is the source of our hope and our joy. We will get through this! Let's continue to wear a mask (cover that nose, too!), wash our hands, keep our loving distance and pray!

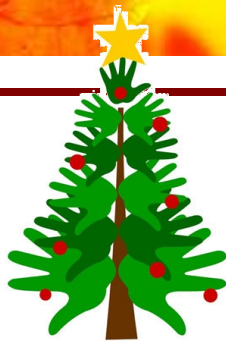
