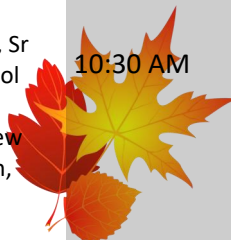

## GOSPEL MATTHEW 25:1-13

Jesus told his disciples this parable:

"The kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. Five of them were foolish and five were wise. The foolish ones, when taking their lamps, brought no oil with them, but the wise brought flasks of oil with their lamps.

Since the bridegroom was long delayed, they all became drowsy and fell asleep.

At midnight, there was a cry, 'Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!'

Then all those virgins got up and trimmed their lamps. The foolish ones said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.'

But the wise ones replied, 'No, for there may not be enough for us and you. Go instead to the merchants and buy some for yourselves.'

While they went off to buy it, the bridegroom came and those who were ready went into the wedding feast with him. Then the door was locked.

Afterwards the other virgins came and said, 'Lord, Lord, open the door for us!'

But he said in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, I do not know you.' Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour."

### Principal's Corner

Peace! Join us in giving thanks to God that our Hybrid schedule took us safely through September and October. Blessed are we.

Our children have been absolutely remarkable. School life is very different and sometimes difficult, but they are resilient. We continue to follow the safety guidelines. We wash our hands frequently, wear masks inside the building (except to eat) and stay six feet apart. Our maintenance department is helping to keep us healthy. They spray our desk shields, wipe high touch areas and clean our bathrooms 18 times a day. The children and teachers go outside regularly for mask breaks. The other day it seemed like Gene Kelly was visiting as the kids were outside, "Singing in the Rain" with umbrellas and smiles.

Our Annual Mission Walk took place with Group I on Tuesday, October 27 and Group II on Wednesday, October 28. We are happy to say our children collected \$1,800 for the Holy Childhood Association. The School food drive went very well for the Cherry Hill Food Pantry. Once again our school families reached out to those in need.

The SJA Class of 2020 will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation the week before Thanksgiving. Pray with them and for them that they may be open to God's Spirit working in their lives. Speaking of the Class of 2020, we would like to acknowledge the awards and scholarships given at the in person graduation held in July. SJA is proud to announce the total amount given in scholarships was \$106,000! Congratulations to all the recipients of these scholarships.

We are extremely happy to announce that the first shipment of Chromebooks has arrived. We are beginning with families that expressed a need for a device for home, followed by distribution to eighth grade students.

Thank you to all who are purchasing Super 50/50 tickets. As you know all the proceeds are part of our school budget. We are deeply grateful for your support. Know that we pray for SJA parishioners every day. We look forward to the day when we can celebrate 9:00 Mass in person with you.

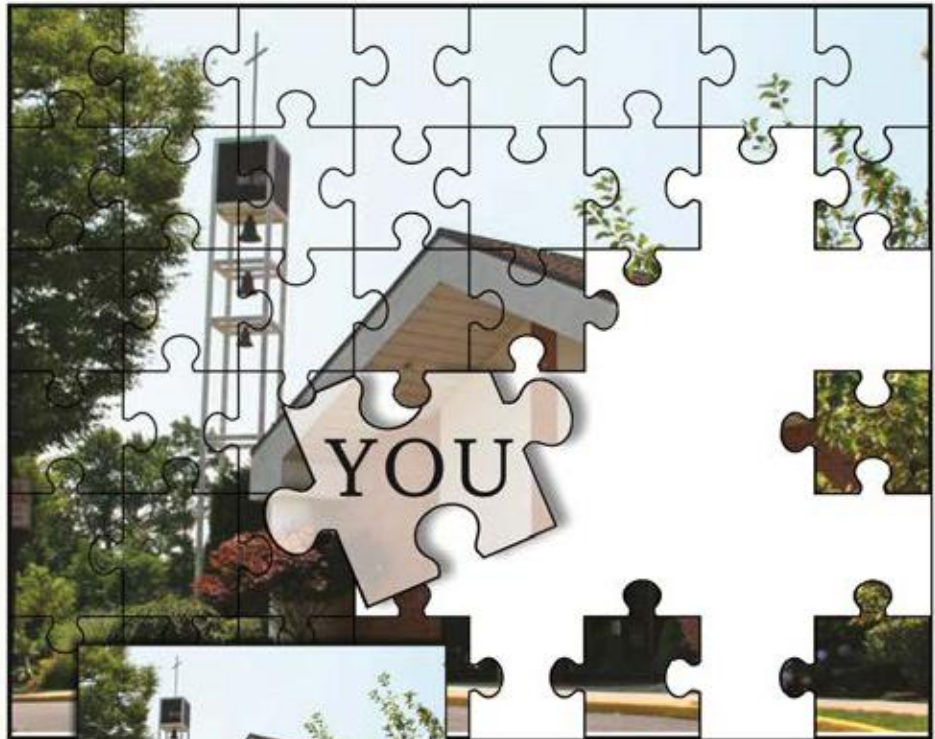

**Who is Peter Faber?**

Peter Faber was born to a peasant family on April 13th 1506 in the village of Villaret in the Duchy of Savoy, Holy Roman Empire.

His childhood and education aspirations lead him ultimately in attendance of the University of Paris. While at university, Peter Faber met, befriended and became roommates with Ignatius of Loyola and Francis Xavier. Faber and Xavier received their Masters of Arts degrees on the same day in 1503. All three men are recognized by Jesuits as founders of the Society of Jesus.

On December 17, 2013, Pope Francis canonized Saint Peter Faber SJ. Faber is regarded as one of Pope Francis' favorite saints, and thought to be the patron saint of small business. He held the belief that a local economy was an integral facet in the lives of a community.

Among his many legacies, The School of Business at Australian Catholic University also known as the Peter Faber School of Business.
